Re: Request to Review Municipal Court Operations and Staff

09/14/2022 I received a memo from Municipal Judge Windorff requesting the review of municipal court operations and staff.

In the memo, Municipal Judge Windorff requested the review of the following items:

- The governing body clarify whether it is their intention to move the municipal judge's office
- The Municipal Judge stipend be increased to \$91,000
- The hours of court clerk be increased to 30-32 hours
- A bailiff or armed guard be provided for court sessions

In reviewing the information provided by Municipal Judge Windorff I would support the City providing a bailiff for court sessions and will direct staff internally to determine a plan to staff this position.

The volume of citations from the Police Department and Code Enforcement does not substantiate an increase in court hours of operations at this time but this is something that the City will monitor for future consideration should the volume increase.

As previously noted, the City recommends 20 hours per week for court clerk with established and posted hours which are adhered to in order to provide customer service to the public and support other departments internally. Previous concerns noted regarding court operation were not surrounding the number of hours per week, but the level of customer service and accessibility of the court.

Kaukauna Municipal Code requires that a Judge be a resident of Kaukauna and over the age of 18. The Code does not require that the Judge be a licensed attorney. While prior study of law may seem relevant for the position, this is not a requirement, and the position is not intended or designed to provide full-time employment and compensation for a licensed

attorney. Historically, the Judge position has been held and successfully completed by other individuals with relevant experience such as retired law enforcement officers.

Staff will collect some relevant historical data on volume of citations, court activity, stipends for other area municipal judges, and municipal code provisions from other area municipalities with municipal courts, so that you will have a clearer context and more relevant comparisons to review in light of these requests.

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS

A meeting of the Board of Public Works was called to order by Chairperson Thiele on Monday, September 19, 2022 at 6:00 P.M.

2. Discussion Topics.

a. Authorization to seek bids for Project 12-22 Grignon Park Stream Restoration and Utility Relay. DPW/Eng. Neumeier stated the Engineering Department is seeking authorization to seek bids for the Grignon Park Stream Bank Restoration project and replacement of the sanitary sewer main in the same corridor. The City has applied for, and received, a DNR grant not to exceed \$135,000 for the stream restoration work. A map of the area was provided. The un-named tributary to the Fox River running through Grignon Park has significant stream bank erosion, contributing to habitat loss and increased sediment and phosphorus loads being washed downstream to the Fox River. The erosion is also causing damage to the trail and disc golf course, and contributing to loss of trees through the corridor. In addition, the sanitary sewer main located along this corridor is clay pipe and in need of rehabilitation. The primary purpose of the project is to reduce urban non-point source pollution prior to discharge into the Fox River by stopping the significant stream bank erosion occurring, but it will also improve many aspects of the park and City utilities. Questions from the Board were answered.

Motion by Antoine, seconded by Coenen to authorize the Engineering Department to seek bids for Project 12-22 Grignon Park Stream Restoration and Utility Relay.

All Ald. vote aye.

Motion carried.

b. Waste Collection Discussion and Ordinance Review.

DPW/Eng. Neumeier provided background information on the current and proposed code information and waste collection. City staff discussed waste collection and agreed an overhaul is needed of the ordinance. DPW/Eng. Neumeier presented a slideshow of the proposed changes. Discussion was held and questions answered.

DPW/Eng. Neumeier will meet with staff and make the recommended changes to firm up costs and find suitable locations for waste collection containers. The draft ordinance will be brought to the Legislative Committee, then to the Common Council for approval.

c. Public Works update.

DPW/Eng. Neumeier provided a list of projects happening in the City. The bridge project is ahead of schedule. The County Highways are paved, but several manholes need adjustment on Hillcrest Drive. The street sweeper needs repairs to the vacuum motor (approximately \$20,000). The Town of Buchanan has approved the proposed speed limit change on Loderbauer. Engineering is working with the DNR and our consultant to close the Phase 4 soil contamination site case dealing with historic pVOC (approximately \$12,000).

Board members should contact the Engineering Department with questions and concerns.

3. Adjourn.

- New Business.
 - Park Donation Application Review

AP Paul presented two park bench donations to be installed on the Nelson Heritage Trail. One bench is donated by Orlando and Janice Jansen and will be installed at the entrance of the trail. The second bench is donated by Ellen Courtney and the John and Ann Courtney Family. This bench will be installed a ways down the trail across from the family's riverfront property.

A motion was made by DPW Neumeier to approve the bench donations for Orlando and Janice Jansen and Ellen Courtney. Commissioner Schoenike seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Outdoor Alcohol Beverage Area Ordinance Review

PCDD Stephenson brought this Ordinance to review. The language is clear enough to determine what a permanent fence is and what is not. Wrought iron style fences that do not reach 50% screening will need a combination of fence and vegetation screening to reach the 50% visibility requirement. DPW Neumeier brought up that there should be complete screening from schools or churches.

A motion was made by Commissioner Feller to forward this ordinance onto the legislative committee with the conditions outlined:

 Section 3.3 to add language "Barriers adjacent to residential and institutional properties shall provide a six-foot tall 100%"

Commissioner Schoenike seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

c. Driveway Ordinance

DPW Neumeier presented multiple options for recommendations for updates to Municipal Code 17.32(3)(c). The following points were discussed and direction was given for DPW Neumeier to draft the discussed changes for new ordinance language.

- Maximum driveway width at curb shall in no case exceed 35 feet 37 feet
- Driveway width at the right of way in Residential Single Family shall not exceed 30 feet to 34 feet
- Rear yard Garage driveway (access from the alley) shall not exceed 50% of the lot frontage on the alley.

No action was taken.

d. Lease Agreement

PCDD Stephenson presented a Lease Agreement between The City of Kaukauna and Don Dix for the lease of a portion of city property adjacent to Bob's Inn for the construction of an outdoor serve area. The lease entailed a one-time payment of \$1. There was discussion if that amount was enough or not. Ald. Moore suggested a \$50 one-time payment. The lease requires insurance, and it gives a 90 day notice for either party to terminate the lease. The land being leased is ~825 square feet which would only take 2 parking stalls from the downtown. The owner would still be required to renew the outdoor serve license yearly.

Re: Kaukauna Pool Project

Staff continues to work with the Sweeney Group on the Kaukauna Pool Project Capital Campaign. Kelly Kelly has agreed to Co-chair the Campaign with Mayor Pentermann. Staff will begin fundraising in October of 2022.

Staff also continues to work with Parkitecture + Planning on the Design Concept that includes the bathhouse, mechanical building, splash pad, mini-golf course, water slide, climbing wall, yard games, shade structures and in-pool play structure. Staff will continue to work on interior furnishing design and color schematics for the interior buildings and outdoor amenities.

Recommended Action:

Staff recommends accepting the Design Concept from Parkitecture & Planning at the price of approximately \$5.8 million dollars with a possible 10% contingency totaling approximately \$6.4 million.

Staff recommends accepting funding this project by \$1.5 million in TIF funds, \$1.5 million in fund balance, \$2 million in CIP and \$1 million in Capital Campaign funds.

Staff recommends accepting the appointment of Kelly Kelly as the Kaukauna Pool Project Capital Campaign Co-Chair.

Staff recommends accepting the Capital Campaign Committee establish a timeline

<u>Yard Games</u> – Cost \$27,000---multi-generational. Appeals to tweens/teens. Option for non-swimmers. Group activity. Minimal maintenance beyond mowing area. No staffing requirement.

<u>Pool Play Structure</u> – Cost \$100,000----Upgrade cost is only the structure, no new equipment or site infrastructure needs, reuses existing pump. More interactive. Adds water movement & vertical color/appeal. More patrons can use concurrently. Appeals to broader age range. Sensory Stimulation. Developing swimmer activity zone. Encourages developing swimmers to explore their environment. Does not REQUIRE an additional guard, user preference.

<u>Climbing wall</u> —Cost \$30,000---upgrade cost is only the structure, no new equipment or site infrastructure needs. Appeals to target teen age group. Handholds/panels are interchangeable and moveable for perpetual revisions to climbing paths. Takes advantage of existing deep well/diving board area. Can swap between diving board and climbing wall to pique interest as each option opens up. Guard swaps between diving board and climbing wall, no additional guard needed. Climbing walls at least 3 panels wide can have 2 concurrent climbers for competitive climbs (group activity). Maintenance includes checking bolt tightness, cleaning panels. Structure stays in place over winter. No additional staff needed.

Splashpad —Cost \$750,000—Added shoulder season use. Zero Entry. No standing water. Separate recirc system from pool (if pool closes for an hour, splashpad still runs). Appeals to broad age range. Access for limited mobility users or non-swimmers. Will be a custom, unique destination feature specific to this facility, drawing users from a wider range. Water will be warmer than pool (solar gain). Visual appeal. Prominent visual feature when approaching the site. Maintenance includes daily water quality checks, maintaining chemicals & equipment. Seasonal maintenance includes startup/shutdown, draining system at year end, full clean of all equipment at startup, reseal concrete every 3-5 years, pressure wash/delime concrete & features if needed. Operational cost will be electric/chemicals, likely \$15k-20k per year range. No additional staff required.

<u>Mini-golf</u> –Cost \$150,000-- Group activity. Broad age appeal. Repeat playability. Patrons stay longer when they can switch between water & dry play. Visibility from road as approaching the site. Activates what is currently a steep hillside with minimal other uses. Increase shoulder season use. Revenue generator. Minimal staffing required, concessions person rents putters/balls. Maintenance could include turf repair, leaf removal, and general cleaning as you've described.

<u>Shade structures</u>-- \$213,000-- Appeal for all patrons. Patrons stay longer when shade is offered. Visual pop of color. Gathering areas. Safety from sun exposure. Marker points for users (i.e. we're meeting under the blue shade structure by the splashpad). Color or shape can be used to define use areas (concessions only allowed under blue shade structure, as an example idea). Replace fabric every ten years or so.

<u>Waterslide</u> –Cost \$250,000--Very visible new feature. Different ride experience from existing slide. Multigenerational. Appeals to teens/tweens. Takes advantage of existing hillside & activates area. Piggybacks on existing access path & staircase. Existing guards can run both slides, no additional guard needed. Increases electrical use because it requires a new pump but does not affect water usage (recirculates from pool vessel). Operational cost is electrical for running pump.

A CSM has been submitted for review by Harris & Associates, INC., agent, for owner, Tom Vanderloop. The purpose of this CSM is to combine the parcels into one. The business building and the parking lot are currently on separate parcels and this lot consolidation would put both the parking lot and the business under one unified parcel. Best practice is for the business and parking lot to share a common parcel, so this CSM is beneficial for cleaning up the current situation. The total area of the final parcel would be 0.66 acres.
