# Red Hills Landfill Update January 2023

#### **General Overview**

Construction on Phase 6 sequence 2 is complete and the DNR is reviewing construction documentation for approval to place waste in the sequence. Approval is expected before May, and the plan would be to start putting waste in the sequence by August.

Our plan was to put material in Phase 5 for the winter. We have been putting material into Phase 5 until the last week. Due to warmer temperatures and thawing, we are temporarily putting waste in the east module of Phase 6. Our plan is to return to Phase 5 as soon as the temperature drops for the remainder of the winter. Once the temperatures consistently are above freezing, we will focus on removing surface leachate from the center module.

#### **Surface Condition**

Below are some pictures from this week at the landfill. The west and east modules are in good condition, and the focus is on the center.

#### Leachate Management



Leachate levels were elevated in late October and early November due to rain, leachate piping construction, and a frozen line. The construction is completed and the line has been heat traced and insulated, so those issues were taken care of. Since then the level has come down nicely.

#### New Leachate Collection System

Construction is complete. Currently Phase 6 is tied into force main.

#### Background

The Engineering Department has completed survey and is finalizing design for installation of concrete streets for the above listed roads (also as shown on the attached maps.)

The new construction streets outlined in the maps are in need of the final driving surface, sidewalk, and driveway apron installation. The Street Reconstruction areas will include removal of asphalt and replacement with concrete street, driveway aprons and extension or replacement of sidewalks where needed.

A preliminary resolution declaring intent to exercise special assessments is included in your packets for Council consideration on Tuesday night.

# **Background**

The Engineering Department and Street Department have identified various areas in need of concrete street panel replacement for which we have budgeted funds in the 2023 CIP. The City would also contract with KU to add any winter water main break patches with our larger replacement project in an effort to save money, staff resources, and to simplify project coordination. Due to several high traffic and school-adjacent patches on this project, we intend to seek bids early in 2023, and require contractors to complete any work on STH 55 or near schools, during the summer months.
