Garbage Truck

Background information:

Bids were received on December 11, 2024, as two separate items for a new automated garbage truck. The bid packet was broken down to separate the chassis from the body. The Street Department postponed a recommendation because of some unfamiliar chassis that were bid.

Low bid on the chassis side came in from Kriete Truck Center out of Green Bay. This truck was demoed by staff and mechanic and there were a few concerns for recommending to award. Operator comfort and visibility, not meeting specifications for horsepower, and having a Mac engine, which would be the only one in the Street Department equipment fleet.

After review of equipment and bids staff believes the Battle chassis with Labrie body is the best option for our operations. Driver comfort, mechanic recommendation, and costs are all factors considered when making a recommendation on equipment. Please see attached bid tabulations.

Strategic Plan:

To continue providing a high quality of life through services the Street Department must replace older equipment to keep up with demand of a growing city and limit down time.

Budget:

The purchase of this new automated garbage truck will be funded from the equipment fund in the 2025 Capital Improvement Plan.

Recommended action:

Authorize the Street Superintended to award bid to R-Now Incorporated for the Battle chassis and Labrie body for a total price of \$391,373.

The Engineering Department has completed survey and is finalizing design for installation of concrete streets for the above listed roads (also as shown on the attached maps.)


The new construction streets outlined in the maps are in need of the final driving surface, sidewalk, and driveway apron installation.



Re: Agenda Item 2d, Mailbox Replacement Policy

Background information:

During collection routes or winter snowplow operations residential mailboxes can become damaged because of proximity to the work area. Currently If city equipment contacts the mailbox and causes damage the city will reimburse for materials in the replacement (no maximum established). No labor costs would be reimbursed, and the city does not provide the reinstallation. Resident/installer is responsible to meet all United States Postal Services installation specifications.

Without a limit on the dollar amount for reimbursement there is potential for the city to reimburse for upgraded/unauthorized materials.

Strategic Plan:

To have a clear reimbursement policy builds into our values of accountability and service to residents.

Budget:

This reimbursement will come from the snow and ice or street maintenance budget depending on the season the damage occurs.

Recommended action:

Approve attached mailbox replacement policy.

MAILBOX REPLACEMENT POLICY

During collections or winter snowplow operations mailboxes can become damaged because of proximity to the work area. The City will reimburse a maximum of \$125.00 for mailbox materials in the event physical contact was made with City equipment.

Property owners should call the Street Department at (920) 766-6337 to report mailbox damage as soon as possible. The City will make a temporary repair or deliver a temporary mailbox so postal services can resume. The Street Superintendent or their designee will investigate any damage and verify if reimbursement is warranted. If damage was caused from snow being pushed to the curb know as "snow load" the City is not responsible for damages unless excessive speed or other operator error caused the damage.

Property owner must install mailbox per USPS specifications. Once mailbox is repaired, if it is determined by the Sreet Superintendent or their designee that reimbursement is appropriate, the property owner shall provide the original materials receipt to the Street Park and Recreation office at 207 Reaume Ave. The City will make a copy of the receipt and verify materials at the damage location. Once materials have been verified the city will send a check to the property owner for materials up to \$125.00.
