Re: **2a) Speed Limit Ordinance 7.02(2) updates**

Background information:

Kaukauna Police Department has found two updates needed in section 7.02 of Municipal Code. The speed limits for County Trunk Highway (CTH) CE and Hillcrest Drive (CTH Z) are currently listed in the Municipal Code as:

7.02 Speed Limits. (2) County Trunk Highways

a) C.T.H. "CE": 35 miles per hour from the centerline of S.T.H. "55" westerly to Fieldcrest Drive and 45 miles per hour from Fieldcrest Drive westerly for a distance of 750 feet.

e) C.T.H. "Q": 35 miles per hour from the centerline of C.T.H. "CE" northerly to a point being 200 feet north of the northernmost leg of Woodhaven Drive and 25 miles per hour within the rest of the city.

- CTH CE had the 35 mph section changed by Outagamie County between STH 55 and Fieldcrest Drive. Currently signed as 45 mph
- CTH Q had the 35 mph section changed by Outagamie County to all 25 mph within the City Limits. Currently signed as 25 mph.

Direct the City Attorney to draft the necessary ordinances to change municipal code for speed limits on sections of CTH CE and CTH Q.

Background information:

Please see attached drawings.

The traffic volume is/will be increasing at several intersections in the City and completion of various subdivision phases and reconstruct projects has led to the need for additional traffic control. The Engineering Department is proposing the installation of "Yield" and "Stop" signs which would help assign the right of way at these intersections.

The City maintains an official traffic map that indicates the location of all stop and yield signs (Sec. 7.03). The common council may make additions or deletions to the map from time to time.

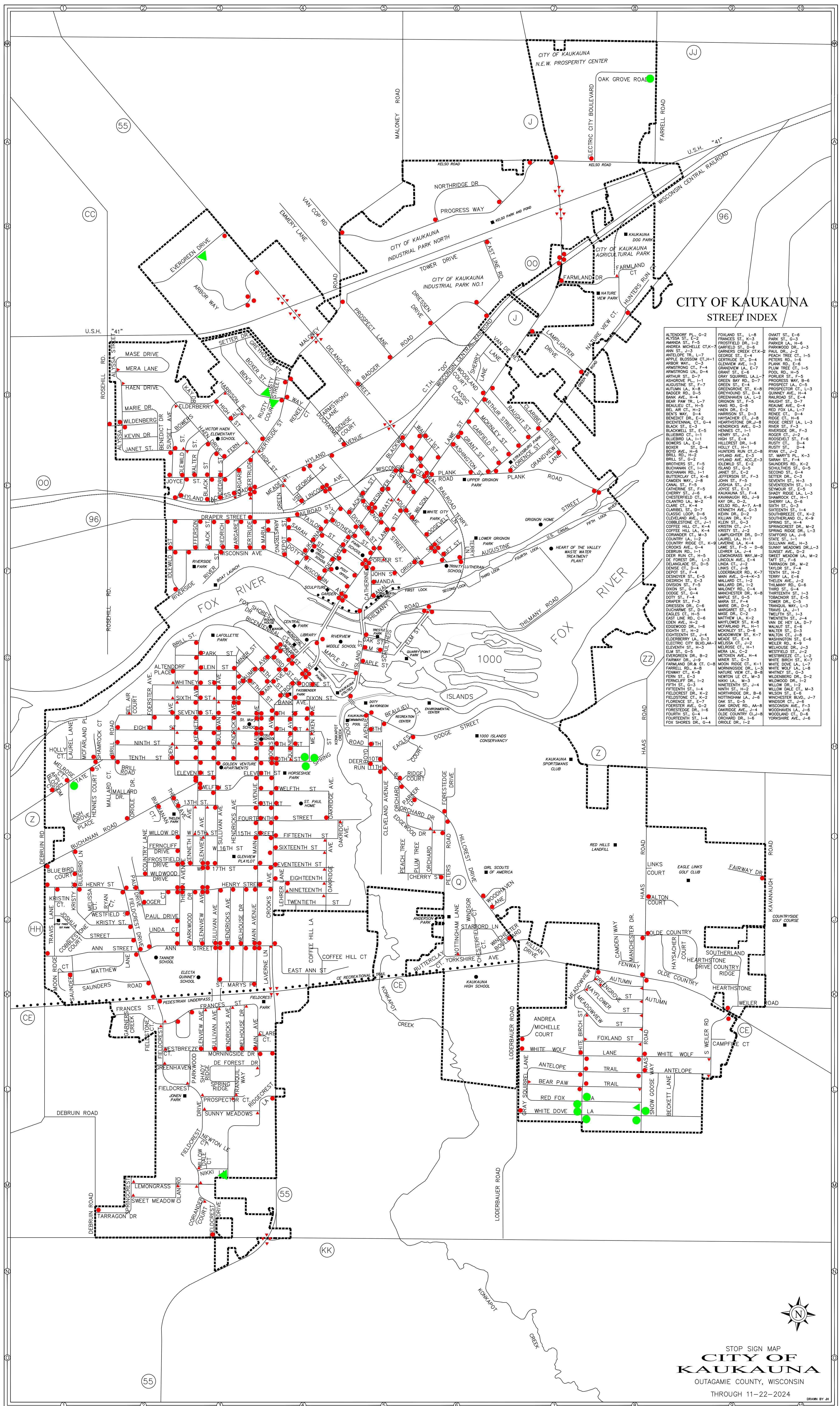
Strategic Plan:

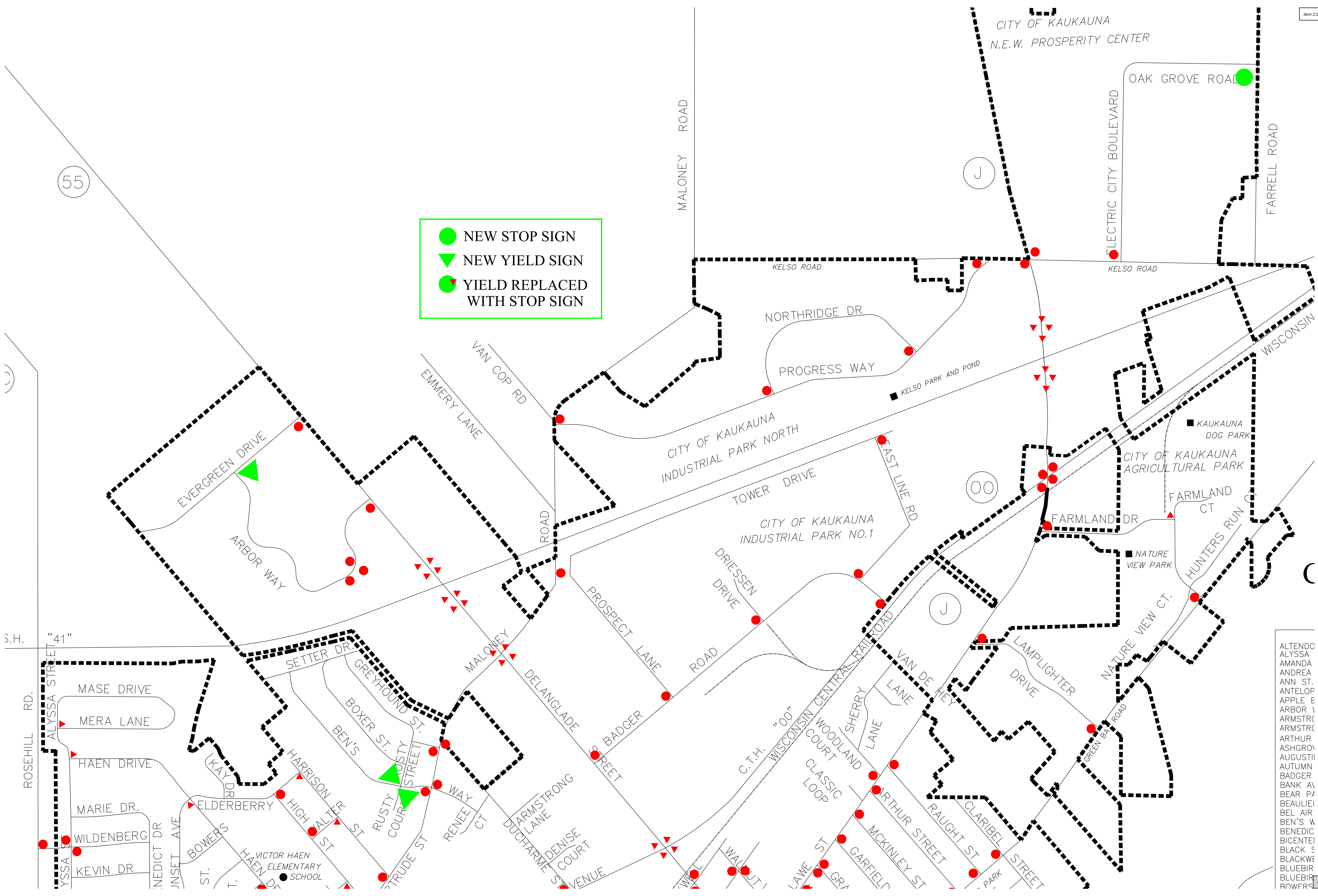
The installation and management of traffic control directly contributes to maintaining a safe and healthy community.

Budget: New signage would be paid from out of the transportation budget.

Staff Recommended Action:

Direct the City Attorney to draft the necessary ordinances authorizing the installation new "Stop" and "Yield" signs at the locations shown on the attached maps, the replacement of existing "Yield" signs with "Stop" signs on Metoxen Ave at E10th Street, and on Red Fox at White Birch Lane, and the removal an existing "Yield" sign on White Dove Lane at White Birch Street.
