

## What is a Historic Resource Survey?

- Gathering information on historic resources to identify those with historical, architectural, archaeological, or cultural significance
  - Research (books, articles, maps, historic photographs, oral histories, etc.)
  - Fieldwork photography to document resources
- Levels of surveying: Reconnaissance vs. Intensive
- Survey products:
  - Inventory Forms
  - Survey Report
  - Research Materials



# Why Conduct a Historic Survey?

## Surveys provide the foundation for nearly all preservation activities

- Document existing historic resources and important histories
- Provide historic contexts to evaluate the significance of resources
- Provide recommendations for further preservation work like:
  - More intensive survey efforts
  - National Register of Historic Places designation
  - Local historic district designation
  - Oral history recordings, etc.

- Taking photographs of resources.
   Photographs are only taken from the public right-of-way.
- Note taking
- Driving slowly through neighborhoods or walking



## **Survey Areas**

- Downtown, Trail Creek, and Knob Hill neighborhoods
- Focus is on resources constructed between 1950 and 1980
- Survey area contains residential, multifamily, mixed-use, and commercial resources
- 115 resources






### **Downtown Ketchum**

- Primarily commercial resources with some residential
- 70 resources


## **Trail Creek**

- Largely residential condos and townhouses
- 35 resources



## **Knob Hill**

- Largely residential resources
- 10 resources
