Discussion on the removal or retention of the temporary 15-minute parking spots, item brought by Suzanne Frick, Director of Planning & Building and KURA. During Covid the City put in many temporary 15-minute parking spots to allow for pick up and drop off since businesses were closed and in take-out mode. Since many are reopened, the spaces are not being used for pick-up and drop-off.

My concern is the vastly increased traffic on Saddle Road. Within the last year or so, the traffic on Saddle road has increased dramatically. The construction related traffic is what is troubling. This road has multiple uses, with Thunder Springs, Big Wood Golf course but it also has residential usage that have driveways that open on to Saddle road. The speed limit is 25mph although I see that routinely disregarded. Plus the large trucks including 18 wheeler's have made the road dangerous. I recently observed a dump truck nearly run over my 80 plus year old neighbor by a dump truck and she was in the cross walk. Is there any way to return our "residential" road to less of a thoroughfare by making Sun Valley road the "Truck Route" for the construction traffic before someone gets hurt.
