3 ADA Sidewalks

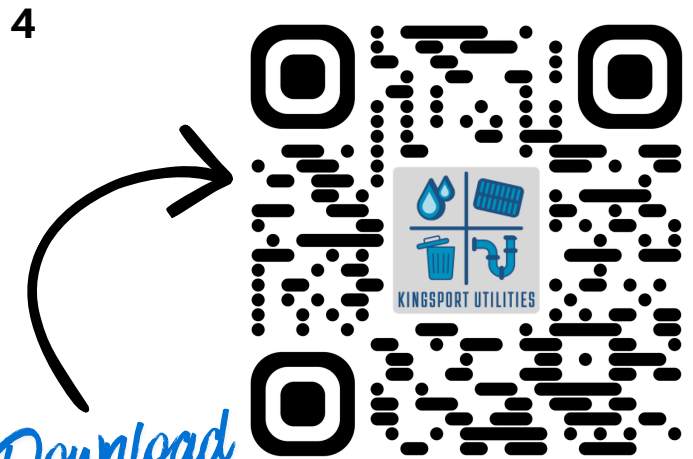
City sidewalk crews are working on ADA sidewalk improvements along Clinchfield Rd.
