3 Justice Center Renovation

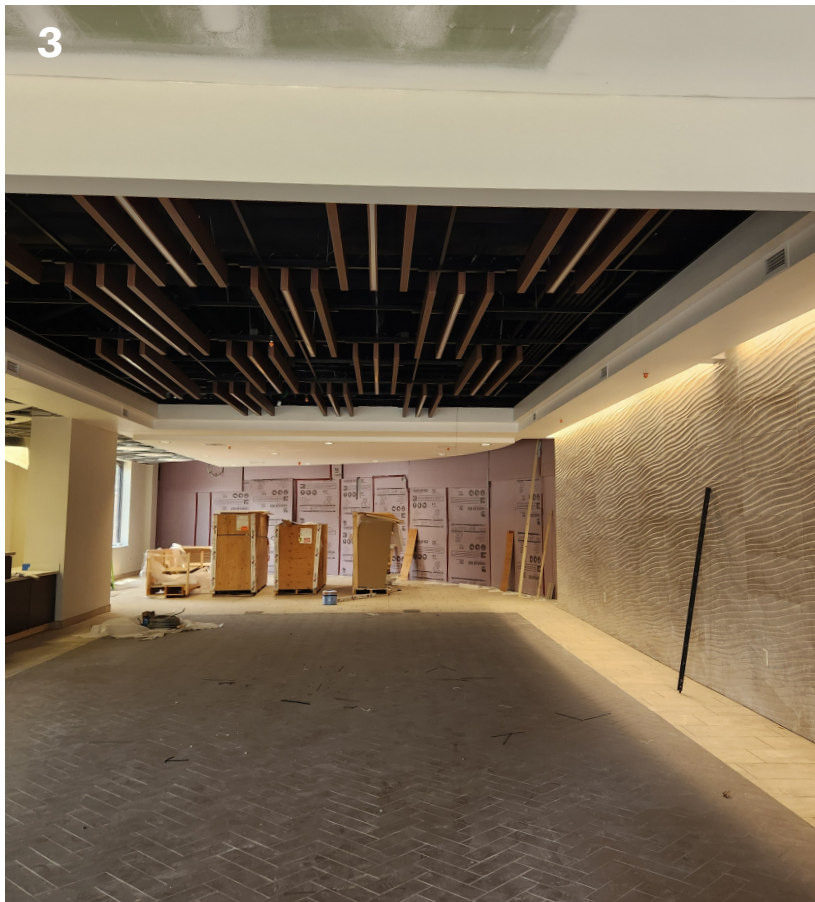
The current project work includes flooring and tile work in the new lobby area.
