Boring has begun under the river and hopeful to moving forward. Demo is set to begin soon. Tentative date is in August.

Temporary disc golf was discussed previously. Looking to reach out to someone for help in getting things set up and moving forward. This will be at the Green Space and only temporary.


Discussion of the Flowering Bridge maybe contributing to some planning on the other side of the lake.


**Adjournment**
