**Parks, Recreation & Lake Report- Dean Givens**

Mr. Givens asked for questions on the PR&L report that was sent out. He stated that the deep-water launch is expected to be completed down to the 12-foot mark this year. Work on the next phase of this project will continue during the next drawdown. Question was asked as to who will have access to the deep-water launch. Town Council has not yet made the decision.

**Green Space Updates- Dean Givens**

Numbers of visitors to The Green Space shows that it is well visited. Town Council and the Steering Committee are working on plans for The Green Space. Discussion was had as to how the creek-side restoration project would affect the Town's use of The Green Space. Mr. Givens responded that there would be a no-disturb area 50 feet on each side of the creek. Staff and the public will be allowed access to this area, but no landscaping/spraying can be done within that area.

**Dittmer-Watts Nature Trail Park- Ed Dittmer**

The trails are in good shape due to the hard work of volunteers and PR&L staff. The connectors are popular. There is an easy loop from Vista Point to The Green Space.

**Buffalo Creek Park, Weedpatch Mountain & the Trail to Eagle Rock - Robin Worcester**

Mr. Worcester reports that a workday is scheduled for 2/14/2023 for cleanup to be done on BCP.

**Lake Lure Flowering Bridge- Maureen Bay**

Ms. Bay reported the Brick Fundraiser is going well. There will be a new art auction coming up. Mill Spring Farm Store is a big supporter of Lake Lure, as well as Flowering Bridge. Taylor University has provided 30 native azalea bushes. Plans are being developed for the volunteer parking area.

**Morse Park – Jim Walters**

Mr. Walters was absent and nothing was reported.

**Programs and Initiatives- Dan Bragdon**

Discussion was had regarding progress on the Luremont Trail. The Town is still awaiting word from the NC General Assembly as to when progress can start.

The cell tower project is set to begin soon.

The Town is preparing for The Rumble which is a rock-climbing event sponsored by Carolina Climbers Coalition. This is scheduled for Lake Lure February 24-26.

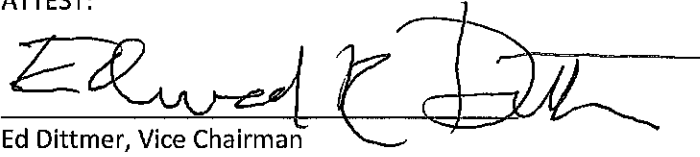
**Adjournment**
