# VI. <u>New Business</u>

A. Lake Structure boathouse permit review for 219 Picnic Point Road. Section 6-51(c) requires that for parcels with less than 35'-100' of shoreline, permit approval will require the board to make a determination that the proposed structure will not materially obstruct the view of the lake from any adjacent upland property

Development and Environmental Review Specialist Richard Carpenter was sworn in.

There were not challenges or ex-parte communications.

Specialist Carpenter explained that 219 Pick Nick Point does not have much linear frontage on the lake. It was noted that the applicant wants to cover their lake structure, which requires the Board's approval. Specialist Carpenter stated that there have been no complaints from adjacent neighbors. It was detailed that the covered boat slip would be code compliant. Specialist Carpenter expressed that he did not see any obstructions of view related to the structure.

The case was closed and deliberations began. Board members expressed that they did not believe that the proposed structure will materially obstruct the view of the lake from any adjacent upland property.

Mr. Gardner made a motion to grant the Lake Structure boathouse permit review for 219 Picnic Point Road as the proposed structure will not materially obstruct the view of the lake from any adjacent upland property. Mr. Hardy seconded and all voted in favor.
