Foothills Regional Commission - Comprehensive Master Plan Presentation and Feedback Request

PRB Communications

Parks, Recreation & Lake Monthly Report

Director Bradley reported that Parks, Recreation, and Lake Department has been busy with several projects including dredging grants and repairs of trails damaged by the massive landslides from the storm. She spoke on the continued development of the Turtle Rock Trail near Pool Creek Park.

Updates of Town Trails

Successful workdays were held throughout the month. Contractors are working on repairs on Buffalo Creek Park, Weed Patch and the Upper Boulders trails. The Lottie Queen Stamper Trail is a new trail that will be opening up once an easement issue is resolved. Chimney Rock State Park and Conserving Carolina are working together to get an entrance for Eagle Rock on that end of the trail.

Lake Lure Flowering Bridge

Susie Ellis of the Flowering Bridge reported that staff and volunteers are making headway in creating garden areas. She was excited to share that they have received the Certificate of Occupancy for the Education Building. She reported that donations continue to come in.

Town Events

Nothing was reported.

Input from Town Council Liaison

Councilman Proctor provided helpful information and input to the Foothills Regional Commission throughout the presentation.

Old Business

Mr. Bragdon reported that he has put up 10 disc golf baskets as a temporary 18 basket course with the potential of being permanent. Supplies Players should bring their own discs. He will provide signs and maps. Director Bradley will present this to Town Council.
