

I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Carol C. Pritchett called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

II. AGENDA ADOPTION

Commissioner David DiOrio made a motion to add item C to Section Vi for Lake Advisory Board presentation and explained that all other boards will be presenting during the Town Council meeting, but it was determined that it would be more appropriate for the Lake Advisory Board to present to the Marine Commission. Commissioner Jim Proctor seconded and the motion carried 4-0.

III. PUBLIC COMMENT

Mayor Pritchett invited members of the audience to speak.

There were no comments from the public.

IV. CONSENT AGENDA

Mayor Pritchett presented the Consent Agenda and asked if there were any proposed changes before calling for action.

Commissioner Proctor made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda, as presented. Commissioner DiOrio seconded and the motion carried 4-0. Therefore, the Consent Agenda incorporating the following item was unanimously approved:

V. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no unfinished business to discuss.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

A. 2023 LAKE USE FEE SCHEDULE

Parks, Recreation, and Lake Director Dean Givens explained that the 2023 fee schedule includes a new 90-day permit for boats not being registered in North Carolina per state law. Director Givens also explained that service and fishing guides have been merged into the commercial category, there is an adjusted fee for out of area businesses, an out of area commercial non-motorized permit, a boat slip moving fee and a late payment fee. Director Givens noted that the weekly timeshare fee had been updated to equate to the same price as an annual resident permit. Director Givens added that there had been updates to daily fees and a \$30 fee had been added for non-peak season daily motorized permits.

Commissioner DiOrio noted that are no longer any weekly permits. Commissioner DiOrio also noted that the Town is limiting non-resident annual motorized to only those with a slip on the lake and that the off-season daily fee was reduced as a result because it should neutralize changes.

Director Givens noted that the main goal is to make the lake safer and that changes are being made in order to grant Lake Lure residents a more tranquil lake experience.

Commissioner Proctor asked if the 90-day permit is for residents or non-residents and Director Givens answered that it is for residents. Commissioner Proctor recommended adding that clarification to the fee schedule. Commissioner Proctor noted that it would make sense to place the 90-day permit under the resident section and Commissioner DiOrio agreed.

Commissioners discussed the importance of regulation enforcement.

Director Givens noted that in the non-resident section, there should be a non-resident annual motorized permit offered for those with a boat slip which is proposed to be \$650 and that it needs to be added. Director Givens requested that Commissioners add this during a motion to approve the fee schedule. Commissioner DiOrio recommending adding verbiage to this for clarification.

Manager Perkins asked if daily non-residents are allowed on the weekends during peak season and Director Givens answered no. Manager Perkins recommended clarifying this.

Commissioner discussed recommended change for the addition of the 90-day permit under the resident section and the addition of the non-resident annual motorized permit.

Commissioner DiOrio made a motion to adopt the 2023 Lake Use Fee Schedule, with amendments discussed. Commissioned Bryant seconded and all voted in favor.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

B. 2023 COMMERCIAL LICENSE BOATING MODEL

Director Givens provided Marine Commission with the proposed 2023 Commercial License Boating Model and provided an overview of the document. Director Givens noted that there are 73 businesses in the model and that the current amount of revenues from the model is \$18,000, but revenues may increase because there will likely be other applications at a later date.

Commissioner DiOrio asked if there are fewer vacation rentals in the model than usual and Director Givens answered that there are a few. Commissioner DiOrio noted that this may result in requests to join different categories the model in lieu of the vacancies in the vacation rental category. Commissioner DiOrio noted that all people who rent from liveries have been informed

of new training requirement. Parks, Recreation, and Lake Department staff reported that the training should be available soon and noted that if there are any issues with technology, the department will have paper copies available at the Parks, Recreation, and Lake Office.

Commissioner Bryant asked if those who submit an application after November 1st will still have to pay a \$100 fee and Director Givens answered yes.

Commissioner Doster made a motion to approve the 2023 Commercial License Boating Model, as presented. Commissioner Bryant seconded and the motion carried 4-0.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

C. LAKE ADVISORY BOARD ANNUAL PRESENTATION

Lake Advisory Board Chair Mark Helms presented the Board's annual report. Chair Helms noted that this year, the Board added three new members including Richard Sayles, Jim Lemmons, and Kathleen Hatfield. Chair Helms reported that the Board spent most of the year working on Lake Use Regulations updates and that notable changes include training requirements, horsepower and speed limits, watersport safety updates, initiatives to protect personal property, weekend congestion initiatives, eliminated non-serviceable boats on the lake, and enforcement of the 90-day North Carolina registration rule imposed by the state.

Chair Helms expressed that in the coming year, the Board plans to update the fishing survey and boat ramp barrier system, evaluate how new Lake Use Regulations are being implemented and enforced, assess impacts of the regulation changes, review the dredging plan, identify buoy locations, and more.

Mayor Pritchett asked if everyone who is driving a boat will needs a license or just the boat owner and it was concluded all drivers will be required to obtain a license and that it is in the Lake Use Regulations.

Commissioner Doster asked for additional details regarding buoy location. Director Givens explained that he is going to launch a study with the Lake Advisory Board and review all buoys on the lake and determine if they are located in practical locations. Director Givens expanded that the Town spends about \$3,000 to \$4,000 on buoys each year. Director Givens expressed that he would like for the Lake Advisory Board to study where buoys are needed on the lake and make a recommendation to the Marine Commission. Commissioner DiOrio noted that there is an application process for buoys and that it has caused issues in the past.

Commissioners thanked the Lake Advisory Board and Chair Helms for their work.

VII. ADJOURNMENT

With no further business, Commissioner Proctor made a motion to adjourn the meetin 4:31 p.m. Commissioner DiOrio seconded and the motion carried 4-0.	g

BRIEF SUMMARY:

Mr. Brian Walker submitted an application for a 2023 boat permit. Upon review, it was determined that Mr. Walker's 2020 Nautique GS20 weighed 4,090 pounds, exceeding the 4,000 pound limit specified in the Lake Use Regulation. Because Mr. Walker's boat was violating Regulations, town staff denied his 2023 boat permit application. Mr. Walker has requested to appeal the decision of Town staff to the Marine Commission.

Mr. Walker, I have reviewed the information that you submitted and after looking into this matter, I have to deny your request for a 2023 boat permit for your 2020 Nautique GS20. According to the Lake Use Regulations, your boat cannot weigh more than 4,000 pounds.

My research contradicts the information that you submitted. Your documents show that the BOATMATE trailer with VIN #5A7BB2029LT003553 is 1,650 pounds. BOATMATE Trailers LLC confirmed that the trailer is actually 1,470 pounds. The CAT SCALE weight ticket you submitted listed the boat and trailer at 5,560 pounds. Subtracting the weight of the trailer 1,470 pounds from the CAT Scale ticket will show that your boat still weighs 4,090 pounds, which is in direct violation of the Town of Lake Lure's Lake Use Regulations.

You have the right to appeal this decision to the Lake Lure Marine Commission. The Lake Lure Marine Commission will have their next meeting on March 14, 2023 at 4 pm. This meeting will be held at Town Hall 2948 Memorial Highway in Lake Lure, NC. Please contact Olivia Stewman at 828-625-9983 ext. 104 to be put on the agenda.

Dean.

Thanks for your time earlier today. Below and attached are the email and boat permit application with documentation that I sent Linda Ward back in 2020. This was submitted through very helpful follow up conversations with you and her. Based on this being approved by the Town to specifically meet the 4,000lb weight restriction (ie - not a rubber stamp by an unauthorized employee), I went through with my purchase.

In regards to the boat trailer that you mentioned, I never purchased one that came with the boat b/c I was just keeping it at the lake and the dealer traveled for service. So for weighing, we just used one of the dealer's trailers. However, it was not heavy enough to register on the CAT scales, so we had to get the trailer weight information directly from the Boatmate production files specific to the actual VIN # for the trailer we used (it is also in the attached documentation). In addition to the boat being 90lbs below the 4,000lbs limit, there were also fluids still left in the boat when weighed that could have been syphoned out to further reduce the dry weight (ie - see email below).

I also wanted to note that I am a very conscientious and responsible boater and resident. I was extremely involved trying to liaison and lead compromise between the more "difficult" wake surf advocates and the Town when working with Mr. Diorio when all the issues came up back in the Summer of 2021. I was also one of the strongest supporters of coming up with and requiring the safety class before permitting to educate people on what the actual rules are (more than half the violators just don't know boating rules/courtesy as no license is required in NC). I am also extremely diligent about the 200' rule for surfing wakes and my family and I actually keep all our wake surfing to the circular center channel area. My family and I are very vested in keeping the Lake Lure shores beautiful and not bothering leisure boaters that are off outside the middle center channel (nor during sunset for that matter, as we are usually out there enjoying it ourselves:).

I am really not trying to be difficult for you or the Town, but I feel I went through a lot of time consuming and diligent steps before making my 6 figure plus purchase. Unlike someone who may have been erroneously rubber stamped, I am hopeful that this past, very specific documentation and weight approval is still just as acceptable today as it was back when I made my decision to go through with that purchase. It would really create quite the hardship for me and my family if it were not. Thank you for your consideration of this information.

If you could please give me a call to discuss after you have had a chance to review it would be appreciated. Thank you so much!


As discussed, attached is the boat permit application, with the letter from Nautique, the DOT weight ticket and photos. The trailer was not heavy enough to register on the scales, but Nautique provided the weight ticket of that specific trailer before going out the door. The math is a gross weight of dry boat and trailer at 5,560lbs, less trailer weight of 1,650lbs = 3,910lbs. There were actually fluids that were still in the boat that they couldn't get out that would even help that weight further.



To Whom It May Concern,

I can confirm that Nautique Boat Company, Inc publishes an approximate dry weight of the Super Air Nautique GS20 as 4,500lbs, but this is based on a boat as equipped with all available options offered by the factory and thus would be the heaviest dry weight. Depending on the options and the weight of the fiberglass components (which can vary by approximately 10% of the dry weight of the boat) it is possible that the true dry weight of the boat is less than 4500lbs. This is visible in the case of Brian 4860 Walker's 2020 Super Air Nautique GS20 with Hull ID# US-CTC0067J920 which when subtracting the Boat Mate trailer weight of 1600lbs is less than 4000lbs on the DOT 1400 scales. The documentation of these weights is included with this letter for reference.

Unfortunately, the weight of this boat does not fit the permitting regulations put forth by Lake Lure Marine Commission. As is stated in § 4.03 (A) (4) of the Lake Use Regulations, "(4) No boat, other than pontoon/tritoon boats, exceeding 4000 pounds dry weight, per manufacturer's specifications, will be permitted on Lake Lure. Adopted 1-12-16".

After considering the engineer's letter, we did not find that it certified an acceptable weight for our permitting requirements.

I can confirm that Nautique Boat Company, Inc publishes an approximate dry weight of the Super Air Nautique GS20 as 4,500lbs, but this is based on a boat as equipped with all available options offered by the factory and thus would be the heaviest dry weight. Depending on the options and the weight of the fiberglass components (which can vary by approximately 10% of the dry weight of the boat) it is possible that the true dry weight of the boat is less than 4500lbs. This is visible in the case of Brian Walker's 2020 Super Air Nautique GS20 with Hull ID# US-CTC0067J920 which when subtracting the Boat Mate trailer weight of 1600lbs is less than 4000lbs on the DOT scales. The documentation of these weights is included with this letter for reference. Please feel free to reach out if you have any additional questions.
