#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

2. Centennial Sponsorship Update

Special Events Director Franks made sponsorship packets available to the members. The following vendors have submitted sponsorships: Forest Development - \$20,000 and Pelican Café - \$250.00. A question was asked if the Town had received \$50.00 from Salty Sign Design. Special Events Director Franks would check with the Finance Department.

3. Centennial Battle of the Badges Special Events Director Franks provided an update regarding the event. There was a question regarding how many volunteers were needed. Special Events Director Franks stated that 20 volunteers would be helpful on the day of the event.

4. Centennial Historical Homes Tour Update & Discussion Special Events Director Franks stated that the Town has received two participation forms. Committee Member Motschenbacher asked if the Town owned any property listed and could those Town owned properties could be checked off the list as participants. Special Events Director Franks stated that she would check the Town owned property off the list. Committee Member Motschenbacher volunteered to visit the properties listed on Hawthorne Drive with Lake Park Historical Society Member Dianne Sophinos. Committee Member Leduc suggested a follow-up letter be prepared for the members to take with them when visiting the homes on the tour list. Committee Member Leduc offered to visit homes with Dianne Sophinos.

Dianne Sophinos asked if 211 Park Avenue had received a historical plaque. Commissioner Taylor stated that the house had a plaque on the property. Dianne Sophinos explained that the original school house is the front area of Lake Park Elementary. She asked if the Trolley route

was determined. Special Events Director Franks explained that the route would be determined closer to the date.

It was determined that Dianne Sophinos would visit properties with each Committee Member separately, during the February 11 and 12th weekend.

#### Jerseys

The jerseys for PBSO and PBCFR have been ordered through Dirty Sports Wear. This is the same company that made the jerseys for the last event.

#### Food & Drinks

#### Music and PA

The Town has hired Gary Wilson of MVP Productions to provide music and pa system.

#### **Vendors**

Town staff has received vendor forms from the participating businesses and organizations that are listed on the vendor list.

#### **Games & Activities**

Town staff has contracted with Jupiter Bounce to provide a 4 in 1 Extreme Sports Game, All American Combo Bounce House and a Climbing Rock Wall. Each activity will be staff by a professional from Jupiter Bounce.

#### **Tents**

Town staff has contracted with C4 Rents to provide the tents for the event.

#### **Tables and Chairs**

The Town will provide all of the tables and chairs for the event.

#### Town Staff

Town staff has hired 4 Public Works staff members to work the event.

#### **Volunteers**

We will need several volunteers to assist with the event. At this time, staff has provided the Battle of the Badges Volunteer Form for the committee to distribute. All volunteers will have to fill out the form in its entirety.
