COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT: Dan Hahn, Josh Hahn, Julia Stuble, John Larsen, Chad Cassady and Mayor White. COUNCIL MEMBERS ABSENT: Melinda Cox. Declaration of a quorum. 1. NEW BUSINESS (NON ACTION ITEMS)

- A. Discussion concerning part of the proposed Lander Municipal Code Title 2 code changes — Demerits, Fines, and Definitions.

Council discussed updates to the liquor ordinance, focusing on aligning definitions with state statute, adding due process protections, and creating a demerit and fine system for violations. Key issues included raising penalties for sales to minors, intoxicated persons, or serving while suspended; clarifying expectations for licensee cooperation with law enforcement; and ensuring TIPS training for all employees handling alcohol. Council Members discussed appropriate fine levels, suspension timelines, and correction plan requirements, while noting that most local businesses already meet these standards. The full document will return for Council review in a future work session before adoption.

Being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 7:19 PM.
