#### **Commercial Business/Property Updates**

- 26780 Southfield Road (44 Burrito) New restaurant. Obtained approval for outdoor patio at the July Planning Commission meeting. They are working on interior renovations.
- 27300 Southfield Road The site plans are under review by the city & planners, and will be forwarded for consideration to the Planning Commission
- City staff & planners met with Surnow Company to discuss proposed façade renovation

#### Infrastructure

- 2023 infrastructure work is nearly complete. Contractors are finishing their respective punch list items. Landscaping touch-up work is expected in the fall.
- Staff and consultants met with RCOC about the resurfacing of Southfield Road in 2024. They are
  intending to have public meetings in the fall.

- DDA is partnering with Oak Park, Southfield, Farmington Hills, and Michigan Works! Southfield office to develop and send a survey to the businesses in our respective communities to help identify desired training/workshop topics.

- MSOC has submitted the grant application for the Revitalization & Placemaking Grant program. A total of 13 communities participated in the regional application. Award notifications are anticipated in the fall.
  - A crowdfunding campaign has been established to securing the remaining match funds. The goal is \$20,000.

Update: This grant application was on the July 21, 2023 DDA Board of Directors agenda; however, Board Member Jones recused herself which lead to an insufficient number of eligible voters. The item was tabled to the August meeting when more members of the board may be present. All remaining memo text remains unchanged.

A Sign Grant application was received by the property owners of 18411 W. 12 Mile Road (Charlotte & Scottie Jones, LOGOS/Hope for All Seasons). The property owners intend to install a new wall sign and update the face panels on the existing monument sign.

The proposed wall sign will be 10.36 square feet and the new face panels total 27.8 square feet, both of which meet standards detailed in the chart below. The wall sign will require a permit through the Building Department; however, the face panels will not require a permit per the ordinance.

The estimated cost of the proposed signage is \$3,459.51.

Per the DDA Sign Grant Program parameters, the LVDDA Board of Directors may approve and provide reimbursement for signage up to a maximum grant of fifty (50%) percent of total project cost or two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00).

Suggested Motion: To award a DDA Sign Grant in the amount of \$1,730 to the property owners of 18411 W. 12 Mile Road to be reimbursed upon installation and final approval by the Building Official.



#### Background:

DDA staff was approached by residents interested in hosting a concert, which the DDA had already been intending to do. Needless to say, we combined forces and began planning the Lathrup Village Music Festival! The planning committee consists of DDA staff, Promotions Committee, Adam Laurie, Jason Hammond, and Lauren Beras. There is a total event budget of \$8,500 which is comprised of DDA funds (\$5,000), Michigan First Credit Union sponsorship (\$2,500), and The Do-Gooders donation (\$1,000).

#### Summary:

LV Music Festival is being planned to be LV-centric. The event is being held on Saturday, September  $30^{th}$  (rain date: October  $1^{st}$ ) in Municipal Park from 2-8 pm. It will feature 6-8 musical performers who have some connection to Lathrup Village or the surrounding area. We have lined-up jazz musician <u>Dave McMurray</u> as the headliner. His total performance fee is \$2,500 and a deposit of \$1,250 is required to secure him as a performer. All other musicians and related sound/stage equipment will each be under \$600.

There will be approximately 24 local businesses – both from the commercial corridor and home-based/makers, as well as a beer tent and food trucks. We have already confirmed two Lathrup Village-based food trucks: 44 Burrito and Wetzels Pretzels, as well as several resident makers.

Promotion of the LV Music Festival will be multi-faceted and will include social media posts, enewsletter and website announcements, signage, posters at LV businesses, etc. We would also like to run a half-page ad in the Southfield Sun on September  $6^{th}$  and a quarter-page ad on  $20^{th}$  for a total of \$1,361.

In addition to local vendors there will be a beer tent to contribute to the atmosphere. As such, the DDA will need to submit to the MLCC for a Special License which is available to non-profits and municipalities. There is a fee of \$50 - 100. The LV Music Festival planning committee is working to secure sponsors for the alcohol sales.

There are three (3) motions to be considered by the DDA Board of Directors:

Suggested motion #1: Authorize the DDA Director to complete and submit a MLCC Special License Application on behalf of the Lathrup Village DDA for the Lathrup Village Music Festival on September 30, 2023, an event to be held in Municipal Park (27400 Southfield Road).

Suggested motion #2: Authorize the DDA Director to enter into a contract/agreement with David McMurray to perform at the LV Music Festival on September 30, 2023 and provide a deposit of \$1,250, with the balance to be paid following the performance.

Suggested motion #3: Authorize the DDA staff to advertise the LV Music Festival in the September issues of the Southfield Sun for an amount not to exceed \$1,361.
