Chairwoman McCeney called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and asked for a roll call. Four (4) Commissioners answered present, constituting a quorum. Chairwoman McCeney then read the Opening Statement.

Chairwoman McCeney asked if there were any other corrections to the Minutes from the Regular HDC meeting held on November 21, 2023. There were none.

On a motion by Councilmember Kole seconded by Ms. Frazier, the minutes were approved on (3) three affirmative votes, With Ms. McCeney abstaining.

Chairwoman McCeney asked if there were any other corrections to the Minutes from the HDC work session meeting held on September 19, 2023. There were none.

On a motion by Councilmember Kole seconded by Ms. Leszcz, the minutes were approved on (4) four affirmative votes.

HDC-2024-0051 for 111 Fourth Street, submitted by Charlene Blankenship, Applicant is seeking approval to paint current iron corner scrolls from white to black color.

The applicant was not present. There was no major discussion.

On a motion by Ms. Frazier seconded by Councilmember Kole, the application was approved on (4) four affirmative votes.

HDC-2024-0054 for **504 Prince George Street**, submitted by **Sandy Revelo**, Applicant is seeking approval to install two (2) plastic 10ft x 8 ft sheds in the backyard.

The applicant was present. Chairwoman McCeney expressed that two (2) sheds seemed excessive and asked if the applicant would be willing to start with one (1) shed and then see if a second shed was needed. The applicant stated they made the calculations ahead of time and they need both sheds for storage. The applicant also stated that you will only see one (1) shed from the street because they are directly behind each other. Ms. Frazier suggested moving the sheds along the fence line and stated that would give the applicant more privacy. The applicant agreed to moving the sheds along the fence line.

On a motion by Ms. Frazier, seconded by Councilmember Kole, the application was approved on (4) four affirmative votes with the addition that the sheds are placed along the alley fence line.

HDC-2024-0055 for **37 Fourth Street**, submitted by **Wilson Crespo**, Applicant is seeking approval to install a new black asphalt driveway.

The applicant was present. Chairwoman McCeney asked the applicant if they were switching to strips. The applicant confirmed it will be strips and stated the reason he requested an asphalt driveway is because it is like the neighbors but there aren't enough coverage for the land, so the applicant switched to strips. Chairwoman McCeney stated that the commission loves the strips, and they are better for the environment.

On a motion by Ms. Leszcz seconded by Councilmember Kole, the application was approved on (4) four affirmative votes.
