- **Disruptive Intrusion of Last Meeting**

Prior to the full Committee meeting on June 15, 2021, the HRPLC Executive Committee members Theresa Bailey, Joyce Moore, Constance Brown and Vivian Summerour Daniel met with Mayor Still and City Manager Chuck Warbington to discuss the Committee meeting held on May 18, 2121 that was disrupted by an intruder via Zoom.

- City Manager Warbington communicated the following:
