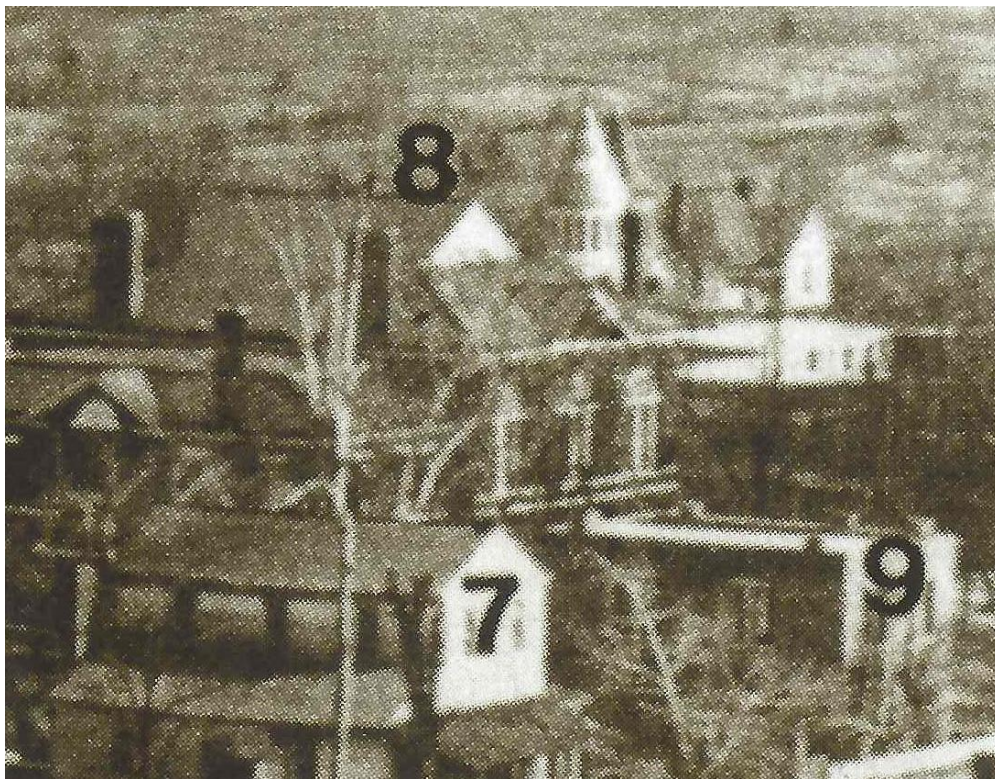

Oak Street is in the foreground and the numbers superimposed on the photograph indicated information on each building. There are too many data points to deliver here, but take a look at item 8. This second slide shows the Gwinnett 1885 Courthouse. The cupola you see was replaced with the now familiar clock tower at the end of 1908 when this picture was taken. Additions to the Pike Street side of the courthouse were made in 1935."
