Mayor David still quoted a Bicentennial Fact from Mary Long's book *About Lawrenceville*. Mayor Still read, "In 1826 there were three churches in Lawrenceville; The Methodist, the Baptist and Presbyterian. The church connected with Fairview Presbyterian Church was established in Lawrenceville in 1823. William Justice Parks was a circuit rider for the Methodist Church and he preached his first sermon in Lawrenceville in 1823 at the log house that was being used as the County Courthouse. The Methodist Church in 1826 was a small wooden building at the intersection of Crogan and East Pike Street. The historic cemetery was originally the church cemetery of the Methodist Church.
