

Materials: Clay brick pavers (Pine Hall Brick Company: Full Range, Rose, Buff, Dark Accent)







ARTISTIC DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS

Artistic brick patterns can be achieved using standard materials and colors from reputable suppliers.

Matching the color palette at each intersection and with the surrounding pedestrian environment contributes a more unified space.

Colors in concrete brick pavers are prone to fading, but clay brick (aka true brick) pavers are not prone to fading.

Color contrast is important for a design to be legible.

Customized colors and precut options are possible through specialty manufacturers such as PaverArt.

The overhead plan view of the design will not be seen by most users.

Existing or proposed utilities may be located within the design.


Granite has regional significance and may be modular or dimensionally cut to many shapes

Endicott brick paver Palette (beveled edges with spacers)









PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS

Craftsmanship is important, especially with more intricate designs.

High intensity use will result in stains and spots.

Bricks should have spacers (lugs) to provide even brick placement. Beveled edged may be desirable to provide texture to vehicles passing over.

Rigid base systems should be used to prevent settling or movement.

Concrete pavers can simulate granite.


