Lawrenceville - Buford Highway Mural Call for Art

The Lawrenceville Arts Commission was organized in 2019 and launched in 2020 to promote the expansion, education, and enhancement of public art in the City of Lawrenceville. The LAC's mission is to emphasize the role of the arts in the cultural enrichment and aesthetic quality of the City's physical environment, the mental wellbeing of the City's residents, and the community heritage, character, and identity of the City as a livable, sustainable, vibrant hub for the arts and artists. Overview

The LAC is creating a collaborative community mural on a high-visibility wall at a key gateway to the historic Lawrenceville Square. The goal of this mural is to make Lawrenceville Square a destination location for art, welcome drivers and pedestrians to Lawrenceville Square, and positively impact the success of downtown businesses while engaging community members in the creation of the mural to increase citizen buy-in and participation in public art.

Project Phases

The phases of this collaborative community mural is as follows:

1. Artist and LAC will work together during the design phase to finalize a design.
2. Finalist will be chosen and designs will be shared to city leadership, City Mayor/Council, and GDOT for final selection
3. Artist will paint the outline of the selected mural design in a "paint by numbers" style with limited colors to allow community members to easily fill in numbered blocks with corresponding paint colors.
4. Artist will provide instructions with a numbered design and corresponding colors that can be used by community members who will participate.
5. Community members will then be invited/register in advance to paint the community mural. The LAC will manage this part of the project.
6. Upon completion, the artist will return to finalize the mural (outlines, touch-ups, complete any incomplete portions, etc.)
7. Artist fee should include to provide maintenance for the mural up to 2x/first year and 1x/year for 5 years



Details

The wall where the mural will be placed is approximately 250 feet long with variable height and a square footage of approx. 2000

Artists will be compensated for their work. Artists will be chosen based off of a preliminary sketch and resume of previous work. Once selected, the artist will be asked to provide a more detailed rendering and design based within the outlined budget proposed. This mural is budgeted at \$???.

Artists will be responsible to provide all their materials required, including paint, to complete their design. If traveling from out of the area, transportation and housing is at the artist's expense. The artist shall provide Liability Insurance.

Design Guidelines

The design should be:

- Happy, uplifting, inspiring and colorful.
- Appropriate material for all ages and absent of political, social statements or influences.
- Can, but does not have to, reference positive historical events, figures or influences of Lawrenceville.
- Include text with a positive, welcoming message that represents Lawrenceville. Text used must be large enough to be readable from a far distance.

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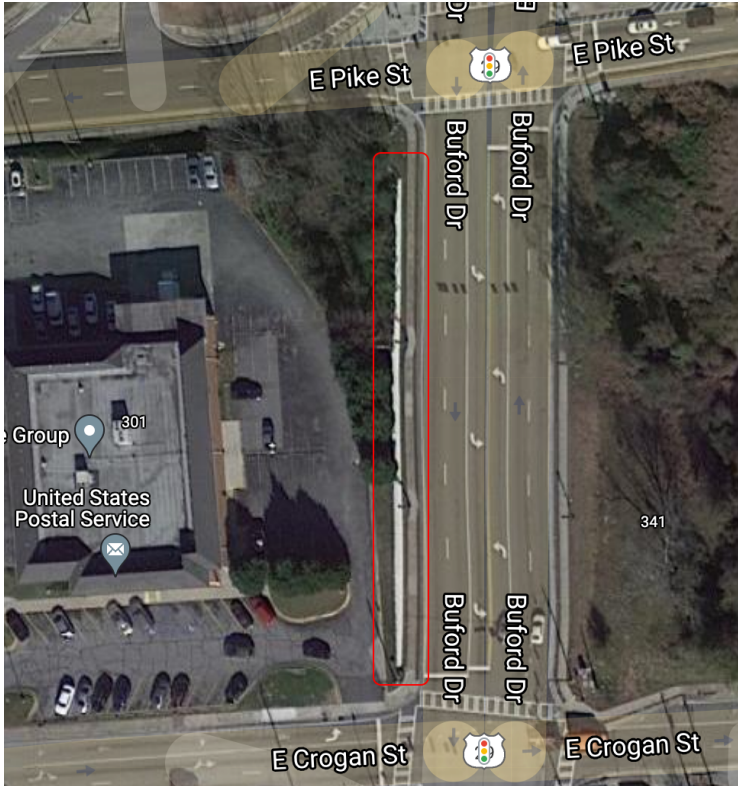
