

**EARTHWISE LIVING COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The Earthwise Living Committee of the City of Leon Valley, Texas met on the 11th day of February at 6:04 pm in the Large Conference Room at City Hall, located at 6400 El Verde Road, Leon Valley, Texas, for the following business, to wit;

1. Call the City of Leon Valley Regular Earthwise Living Committee Meeting to Order and Determine a Quorum is Present.

The meeting was called to order, and a quorum was established at 6:04 pm. Members present were Chair Campos, Burnside, Zannaras, Castillo, Marcotte, and Vazquez. Also present were Council Liaison Mayor Riley, Staff Liaison Miranda, and City Councilperson Place 5 Mursch. Absent members were Secretary Meffert, Perez, and Key.

**2. Review and Consider Approval:
January 2026 Earthwise Living Committee Meetings minutes**

The meeting minutes from January 14, 2026, were reviewed. Castillo made a motion to approve. Burnside seconded the motion.

3. Discussion and Possible Action on EWL Day Event Confirmed Applications

A discussion was held to vote on the new exhibitor applicants, *St. Luke's Catholic Church - Social Justice Committee* (SJC) and *Make Texas Healthy Again* (MTHA). Regarding SJC, Castillo motioned to approve. Marcotte seconded the motion. Regarding MTHA, Marcotte motioned to reject. Castillo seconded the motion. Reasoning was for opting for non-political vendors/exhibitors.

4. Discussion and possible action to review and approve the event itinerary, including recognition of sponsors, contributors, and performers.

The event's itinerary was discussed and approved with some adjustments made. EWC agreed to move the Native Dancers from 9:05 AM to 10 AM. The Conjunto band will be moved to 10:30 AM, and Castillo will need to reach back out to them as they requested three microphones, but the event center only has one.

5. Discussion and possible action regarding exhibitor and vendor layout in our community center.

An important announcement was made by City Manager Crystal Caldera, PhD, regarding the Leon Valley police department needing a general estimate and layout of Earthwise Living Day months ago for staffing needs. Moving forward, the EWC will work to provide a general layout to LVPD ahead of time. General discussions were also made regarding staging food vendors (Njoy Thai Food, Go Vegan SA, Bike Coffee). The consensus was that the food vendors should be staged outside, but Njoy requested to be inside as they are serving pre-made food items with no cooking required. With that, Go Vegan's food truck and Bike Coffee will be staged outside while Njoy will remain inside.

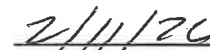
6. Announcements, Updates, and Other Business.
