A RESOLUTION TO RELOCATE THE POLLING PLACE FOR PRECINCTS 10-04 AND 10-05 FROM GREENWOOD RECREATION CENTER, 1306 CORNELL AVENUE, RUSTON, LOUISIANA, 71270 TO LINCOLN PARISH H.E.L.P. AGENCY, 402 MARTIN L. KING DRIVE, RUSTON, LOUISIANA 71270, AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING WITH RESPECT THERETO.

WHEREAS, the established polling location for Precincts 10-04 and 10-05 are located at Greenwood Recreation Center, 1306 Cornell Avenue, Ruston, Louisiana 71270; and,

WHEREAS, that location is no longer suitable for use as a polling location; and,

WHEREAS, Lincoln Parish H.E.L.P. Agency, 402 Martin L. King Drive, Ruston, Louisiana 71270 is willing to accept these precincts; and

WHEREAS, the proposed polling place meets all requirements for polling places.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lincoln Parish Police Jury, in regular and legal session convened, that the Lincoln Parish Police Jury does hereby change the polling locations for Precincts 10-04 and 10-05 from Greenwood Recreation Center, 1306 Cornell Avenue, Ruston, Louisiana 71270 to Lincoln Parish H.E.L.P. Agency, 402 Martin L. King Drive, Ruston, Louisiana 71270.
