The Public Works Committee of the Lincoln Parish Police Jury met at the Lincoln Parish Library Events Center, Tuesday, May 11, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. Present were: Matt Pullin, Chair, Theresa Wyatt, T.J. Cranford, Logan Hunt, and Glenn Scriber.
