The Public Works Committee of the Lincoln Parish Police Jury met in the Police Jury Meeting Room, 100 West Texas Avenue, Ruston, Louisiana, Tuesday, March 10, 2026 at 5:00. p.m. Present were: Greg Williams, Chair, Dan Lord, T.J. Cranford, Milton Melton, and Diane Richards

Chair Greg Williams called the meeting to order, and Milton Melton delivered the Invocation.

Dan Lord offered a motion, seconded by Milton Melton, to approve the Agenda as presented. The motion carried with the following votes:

Chair Williams called for Public Comments on Agenda Items. There were none.

First item on the Agenda was to consider and take action if necessary, setting speed limits on Water Tank Road.
