

The Lincoln Parish Police Jury met in special session on Tuesday, May 15, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. in the Police Jury Meeting Room, 100 West Texas Avenue, Ruston, Louisiana. Present were: Hazel Hunter, District Two; Richard I. Durrett, District Three; Logan Hunt, District Five; Glenn Scriber, District Six; Skip Russell, District Eight; Sharyon Mayfield, District Eleven; and Annette Straughter, District Twelve.

President Durrett called the meeting to order, and Logan Hunt delivered the Invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Annette Straughter offered a motion, seconded by Sharyon Mayfield, to approve the Agenda as printed. The motion carried with the following votes:
