The motion carried with the following votes:

Mr. Earnest Finch with Thomas and Farr Agency, Inc. was present to review the Group Health Insurance options. Mr. Finch recommended switching carriers from United Healthcare to Blue Cross/Blue Shield for both active employees and retirees. All ancillary coverages would remain with present carriers. After discussion, Chris Garriga offered a motion, seconded by Dan Lord, to accept the recommendation. The motion carried with the following votes:
