City of Lake Forest Park – Tree Board Meeting Meeting Minutes: May 07, 2025; 7:00-9:00pm Hybrid Meeting Held in the Forest Room at City Hall and Virtually via Zoom Tree Board Members present: Richard Saunders, Victoria Kutasz, Stacey Spain, Doug Sprugel, and Mark Phillips Staff and others present: Larry Goldman, LFP City Council; Drue Epping, Urban Forest Planner; Elizabeth Talavera, Assistant Planner Members of the Public present: BJ Hedahl Tree Board Members absent: Richard Olmstead Call to order: 7:00 PM Short Reflection: LFP resident, BJ Hedahl, gave a short reflection on her experience growing up in the City of Lake Forest Park. **Introductions:** No introductions. Approval of Meeting Agenda: Board member Sprugel motioned to approve the agenda; Board member Saunders seconded. The agenda was approved unanimously with no changes. **Approval of Minutes:** Board member Saunders motioned to approve the minutes; Vice Chair Kutasz seconded. The April 2025 minutes were approved unanimously with the suggested edits. **Public Comment:** No public comments. **Next meeting:** The next meeting occurs on June 04, 2025. Reports and Announcements: Tree Board Update Vice Chair Kutasz gave an update on the Climate Policy Advisory Team meeting. The CPAT team debuted the draft of the Climate Element at an open house.
