(1) I was the presiding officer of a meeting of the Loganville City Council held on the 6th day of March 2023.


(2) That it is my understanding that O.C.G.A. & 50-14-4(b) provides as follows:


(4) This affidavit is being executed for the purpose of complying with the mandate of O.C.G.A. 50-14-4(b) that such an affidavit be executed.
