6. **705 Vista Grande Avenue Two-Lot Subdivision:** Consider adoption of a resolution approving an application for a tentative parcel map to subdivide a 26,708 square foot parcel at 705 Vista Grande Avenue into two lots. The proposed subdivision would create a 12,166 square-foot corner lot, a 10,120 square-foot interior lot, and dedication of the street frontage for the public right-of-way along Springer Road. A categorical exemption pursuant to Section 15315 (Class 15), Minor Land Divisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines will be

considered. On March 3, 2022, the Planning Commission reviewed the proposed project during a public hearing and recommended City Council approval. (S. Golden)
