Activity	Increase the share of people walking, biking, and riding transit to work to 10% by 2030 and 20% by 2040.
	Increase the share of students walking and biking to school by 10% by 2030.
Safety	Reduce the number of collisions in the community involving people walking, biking, and/or driving by 50% by 2030.
	Work to eliminate all collisions resulting in severe and fatal injuries by 2030.
	Reduce before and after traffic speeds and cut-through rates on projects aimed to address those issues.
Connectivity	Implement at least 10 high-priority projects by 2030.
	Decrease the number of gaps in pedestrian and bicycle networks by 50% by 2030.

- 1. Reorganization of the department and division.
- 2. Award of On-Call contract for Transportation Engineering Services.
- 3. Three (3) new hires for the department.
- 4. Evaluation of Jardin Dr completed construction and determination to develop an improved design with extensive community engagement.
- 5. Three (3) concept plans prepared for review and comments- sent to Santa Clara Fire Department for review (end of December 2023).
- 6. Damaged RRFB at San Antonio Rd and Loucks Ave scheduled to be replaced with a fully operational, double sided LED, audible system.
- 7. Field inspection and evaluation of all Los Altos RRFB systems to determine locations in need of immediate improvements.
- 8. Response and improvements to outstanding resident complaints.
- 9. Response and meetings with schools seeking traffic operations improvements.
- 10. Review of permit applications in queue and preparation of response letters to applicants.
- 11. Review of funded projects, additional funding needs, and determination of projects the department can focus on and deliver in 2024.
- 12. Preparation of the 2024 Work Plan and staff assignments.
