Electrification Working Pair Update

LOS ALTOS ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION March 12, 2024



Proposed Electrification Working Group Suggested Goals

Develop recommendations to support and accelerate building electrification in Los Altos through policy, incentives, community engagement, and the Los Altos the Climate Action and Adaptation Plan (CAAP).

- Policy Research and propose electrification ordinances and guidelines for new construction and major remodels, evaluating options such as REACH Codes, NOx ordinances and building incentives.
- **Incentives** Identify and recommend city-sponsored and third-party incentives that encourage the electrification of new and existing homes (monetary and non-monetary).
- Community Engagement Expand education on electrification benefits and available incentives through public engagement, workshops, and collaboration with local organizations.
- Climate Action and Adaptation Plan Work with city staff and sustainability partners to ensure
 effective notification and execution of electrification initiatives, aligning with evolving state, county,
 SVCE, BAAQMD programs and efforts.
