Board member Marco Huerta explained the sign located at the Ash Tree Plaza needs to be replaced. The cost estimate to replace is \$104,131.78, all four business located at the plaza have agreed to participate in the replacement and are requesting the matching grant of \$3,750 each business a total of \$15,000.

Mr. Huerta recommended to approve the sign grant for the Los Fresnos Ash Tree Community Plaza, the CDC portion would be \$15,000 and reminder balance be split by the business.


