RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION FOR CONVEYANCE OF BOTTOMLANDS LAKEWARD OF LOT 83, ASSESSOR'S PLAT NO. 2, MACKINAC ISLAND, MICHIGAN

WHEREAS, the City of Mackinac Island ("City") is a Michigan municipal corporation located within Mackinac County, Michigan; and

WHEREAS, the Straus Family Trust ("Trust") is the equitable owner of Lot 83, Assessor's Plat No. 2 of the City of Mackinac Island, Michigan, which is more particularly described on **Exhibit A** ("Property"), and which Property is located within the boundaries of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Trust is seeking to acquire from the State of Michigan certain filled bottomlands between the Property and Lake Huron, which is described on **Exhibit B** ("Bottomlands"), so as to have uninterrupted title to the Lake Huron shore and to facilitate the construction of a dock into Lake Huron; and

WHEREAS, the City has no objection to conveyance of the Bottomlands from the State of Michigan to the Trust.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City approves of conveying title of the Bottomlands from the State of Michigan to the Trust and to the Trust's uninterrupted title to the Lake Huron shoreline and potential construction of a dock into Lake Huron as may be permitted by the applicable authorities. The City reserves the right to exert zoning jurisdiction over the project and also reserves any other rights it may have. The City's approval of this conveyance is not to be construed as a waiver of any Federal, State or local law or regulation related to the Property proposed for conveyance or the use of said Property.

# <u>City of Mackinac Island</u> Audit Procedures for Granting Real Property Exemptions Policy

The City of Mackinac Island Office of the Assessor, headed by the City Assessor, is charged with locating, identifying, and valuating all taxable real property and personal property within the City of Mackinac Island to provide a fair and equitable basis for taxation.

The office of the assessor maintains descriptions of real property, maintains maps showing the ownership and tax districts for the City, and processes property tax exemptions.

Property tax exemptions are granted based on three elements:

- 1) Property ownership,
- 2) Property use, and
- 3) Statutory definition

Taxpayers receiving an exemption may be required to apply through the assessing office or other designated office. Michigan State Law includes a range of mandatory exemptions and optional exemptions available for residential, commercial, and industrial property.

The office of the assessor conducts annual reviews and maintains information for those properties that are exempt from taxation to determine whether such properties continue to qualify for an exemption. The annual review of exemptions ensures that properties are correctly assessed and validates the ownership and usage of the properties; some mandatory exemptions are not reviewed since the assessing office has no option but to grant the exemption.

Active monitoring of changes to recorded title, public information review, and periodic field inspections is included as part of the annual review of exempt property. The primary elements of an exemption determination are based on the ownership and use of the property depending on the type of exemption.

The office of the assessor reviews property ownership as part of the first consideration for an exemption determination. Secondly, assessing officer or staff confirms that the property is in use for nonprofit exempt purposes. In the case of small business taxpayer exemption, poverty exemptions, disabled veterans and residential exemptions, there are specific requirements related to occupancy and other criteria related to each exemption.

The office of the assessor annually reviews exemption determinations employing four elements depending on the type of exemption as follows:

- All property ownership records are monitored to confirm continuance of ownership to the exempt entity or person through review of ownership records held at the Mackinac County Register of Deed.
- 2. The office of the assessor annually inspects over 5% of properties throughout the City of Mackinac Island and notes any changes to exempt properties for review.

- 3. The office of the assessor monitors public information concerning exempt properties and owners.
- 4. The office of the assessor conducts annual reviews of exempt property for ownership and use conformance to exemption programs to include cross reference to the City of Mackinac Island Records, public information reviews (business licenses, articles of incorporation, web sites and periodicals), and property inspections.

The office of the assessor also strives to maintain files with sufficient documentation to support the decision to grant the exemption. For example, religious exemption files need to include copies of the articles of incorporation, Internal Revenue Service determination of nonprofit status, usage statement, contracts for use of the property by other than the applicant organization, and financial disclosures.

Exemptions records are maintained in two ways. The primary system is the BS&A computerized data system that retains information regarding ownership, location, physical description, inspection dates staff comments, and exemption status. The system is generally adequate and contains sufficient data to administer the exemptions.

The second data system is a paper file system that includes the original application and the documents and correspondence that supports the exempt status. The primary source for documenting and exemption is the paper application that is submitted along with supporting documentation.

Hi Danielle.



This correspondence is coming directly from our Island Dock Lead, Ian — who the past couple years has been the one to hang the banner per my instructions. He sent me the picture of what he did last year (also drew up what he envisions for this year, both pictured below) and mentioned he likes the benefit these extra grommet anchors will give. Reflecting on last, there was very little give from the line on the left, even after multiple windy days and no grommets along the bottom. He mentioned the banners also have cut outs within them to allow air flow cutting down on wind resistance.

"We use twine, wrapped around the two points multiple times to prevent slack and give on our anchor points. On the top edge we have metal hooks that can be moved to accommodate any grommets. On the bottom corners we have tied down straight across to prevent any slack of movement. If the bottom edge has multiple grommets we can weave a line along the bottom edge and then anchor straight across to minimize even more movement. It would be as if the banner was anchored from all edges, while allowing guests to walk underneath. I (Ian) have consulted my certified mechanical engineer Uncle on the project should this plan not meet the city standards for a better solution."

I hope you can see our transparceny in this commucation to ensure we aren't doing anything intentionally to be in violation. I know Dennis mentioned it is not on him/you to tell us exactly how to achieve the banner tie down requirement of being tied/fastened around the perimeter at a 2 foot max spacing as it's been a requirement on Mackinac Island for many years now. With that statement, I have been reviewing the sign and display ordiance on cityofmi.org and I cannot locate further direction on what has been preapproved for the tie down material — understanding these special events are on a case by case basis. So I will ask if twine can continue to be acceptable?
