Olson told the board that the CAC Conference was amazing but also one of the most stressful things. He met people from all over the world that came in for this and they specialize in this type of work. He received a lot of contact information and also has someone that is going to help him with a cost analysis to become part of an international team that works on internet crimes against children. He explained that when they have something in your area you become a point of contact for them to help with the investigation. He would mostly stay in his jurisdiction unless someone needed him to assist. He thanks everyone for the opportunity.

OTHER ITEMS

6. Discussion and possible action regarding the use of the water department's purplewave funds of \$25,475 plus \$33,528 from sanitation's vehicle outlay funds that were previously allocated to vehicle purchases, to total \$59,003 to purchase a new vehicle for the water department.

The City Manager explained that it was budgeted for the city to purchase 3 vehicles with \$150,000. Kyle explains that they have purchased 3 vehicles, replacing 2 for parks and one for the mechanic then reallocated one to recycle. There is \$33,000 left from that \$150,000 and the water department pickups are in bad shape and constantly in the shop. He suggests they take the rest of the money previously allocated plus the water department's purplewave money and purchase a new pickup for them. Mora added that when she started as a city clerk in 2022 this was brought to her attention, and it should have been parked then. She added that Kyle did such a great job shopping around for the 3 vehicles that he ended up with \$33,000 left over and the purplewave money is already allocated to the water department so we are not asking for any additional money, just to reallocate it for this purchase.

7. Discussion and possible action regarding selling parts of the Mangum Power Plant to Pawhuska, OK.

Layman explained that the City of Pawhuska has a power plant similar to ours and a couple of their guys came down last week to look around. They are interested in purchasing parts from ours, but Layman has no idea how much to charge them. He discussed getting an exact parts list and contacting Fairbanks Morris to see what they would charge for the parts.

Chapman asked if they were interested in making an offer. Layman explained at the time they were not, but they were just a couple of workers.

Kendall explained that this project was started in 2022, and everything must be finalized by the 14th of October in order for us to avoid any penalties. The landowner for the easement lives out of town, but they did meet with him just before the meeting. He did not sign the easement because he wants some compensation. Currently the other East landowner that pulls water from the lagoon uses the bulk of the water allowed for use. This South landowner is requesting to be able to use more water from the lagoon so that he can expand the number of acres he is watering, which is currently 60 acres. The South landowner is also seeking monetary compensation for the land we will occupy. Kendall stated that he is going to work on this and hopes to have it finalized by the next meeting. Item will be tabled until October 1st meeting.
