**WHEREAS** The Act in section 17-215 provides for the chief executive office of the City, or designee, as authorized by the governing body, to transfer any unexpended and unencumbered appropriation from one department to another within the same fund; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MANGUM, OKLAHOMA:

**SECTION 1**. The City Council does hereby authorize the City Clerk to transfer any unexpended and unencumbered appropriations, at any time throughout FY 2025-2026, from one line item to another or one object category to another within a department without further approval by the City Council.

**SECTION 2.** All supplemental appropriations or decrease in the total appropriation of a fund shall be adopted at a meeting of the City Council and filed with the State Auditor and Inspector.
