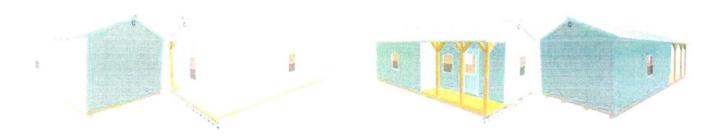

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-74 OF THE MARIETTA CITY CODE, TO PROVIDE SALARIES FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. Section 2-74 of the Marietta City Code is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-74. Salaries of elected officials.

- (a) The following salaries and rates of compensation are established for the elected officials:
 - (1) Mayor, \$275.00 per month.
 - (2) Councilmember, \$150.00 per quarter.
 - (3) Treasurer, \$275.00 per month.
 - (4) City Clerk, \$275.00 per month.
 - (5) Street Commissioner, \$25.00 per month.
 - (6) Marshal, \$25.00 per month.
- (b) The salary becomes effective at the beginning of the new term of each elected official.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, repealed.
