



POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

June 25, 2026 at 5:30 PM

303 Mansion Street Mauston, WI

1. **Call to Order/Roll Call:** The Police and Fire Commission met on June 25, 2026, in the Council Chambers at Mauston City Hall. Chair Brian McGuire called the meeting to order at 5:34 p.m. Members present were Jack Hammer, Brian McGuire, Gary Purvis, Katie Gruman, and Deborah Shuman. Also present were Fire Chief Brent Lenorud (left the meeting at 5:54 p.m.), Police Chief Michael Zilisch, and City Administrator Daron Haugh.
2. **Minutes:** Motion by Gruman, seconded by Purvis, to approve the minutes of May 28, 2026. Motion carried by voice vote.
3. **Financial Report:** Motion by McGuire, seconded by Gruman, to approve the financial report as presented. Motion carried by voice vote.
4. **Fire Chief's Report:** Fire Chief Lenorud reviewed the May 2026 calls for service. There were seven (7) calls in the City of Mauston, four (4) in the rural area, and two (2) mutual aid calls, totaling thirteen (13) for May 2026. The Commission discussed next steps regarding firefighters who have had limited participation in calls and training activities over the past one to two years. City Administrator Haugh reported that the Recognition Event planning is ongoing, and he hopes to have it finalized shortly. Motion by McGuire, seconded by Hammer, to approve the Fire Chief's report. Motion carried by voice vote.
5. **Police Chief's Report:** The May 2026 calls for service totaled 1,701, compared to 1,744 in May 2025 and 1,699 in April 2026. Last month there were 1,699 calls. Chief Zilisch reported that the Police Department did training on high risk vehicle traffic stops as well as Taser training. He also reported that Officer Noe and K9 Pilot had their annual recertification. Lastly, there was a discussion on recruiting for the patrol officer position and other personnel updates. Motion by Hammer, seconded by Purvis, to approve the Police Chief's report. Motion carried by voice vote.
6. **Closed Session Matters:** Nothing to report.
7. **Adjourn:** Motion by McGuire, seconded by Gruman, to adjourn. Motion carried by voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 6:18 p.m.
