Jones Park Restructuring: Rob Nelson and Jordan Wilke will move forward in putting together the budget for restructuring Jones Park to a universal athletic field. The budget will generate the bid proposal. The project scope includes fencing, grading and drainage, light and tree/stump removal. Jordan and Rob will repurpose as much of the current fencing as possible. They will look into a 2% crown with the many options of topsoil and sod/seeding and in ground irrigation. Jordan Wilke will look into getting the antiquated water wheel up and running? Questions about repurposing the current dugouts, concrete pad under bleachers and the bleachers, themselves, still plague their thoughts. Portable soccer and football goal posts are under consideration. The dilapidated parking lot on the south end zone will also be improved. For future thoughts, the Board will look into making improvements on the restrooms.
