# POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION MINUTES

February 27, 2025 at 5:30 PM

303 Mansion Street Mauston, WI

1. **Call to Order/Roll Call:** The Police and Fire Commission meet on February 27, 2025, in the Council Chambers of Mauston City Hall. Chair Brian McGuire called the meeting to order at 5:37 p.m. The members present were Jack Hammer, Katie Gruman, Brian McGuire, and Deborah Shuman. Absent was Gary Purvis. Police Chief Mike Zilisch, Fire Chief Brent Lenorud, and City Administrator Daron Haugh were also present.
2. **Minutes:** The motion was made by Gruman, seconded by McGuire to approve the minutes of January 23, 2025 and February 13, 2025. Motion carried by voice vote.
3. **Financial Report:** Motion made by Hammer, seconded by Shuman to approve the Financial Report as presented. Motion carried by voice vote.
4. **Fire Chief's Report:**
  - a. The commission reviewed the calls for service in January 2025 and the Fire Chief explained them. Chief Lenorud reported that the department hired one new firefighter, and is reviewing an application for a second firefighter. He also gave an update on the work that is being done on the fire station floor.
  - b. Chief Lenorud presented a request to increase the hourly pay rate for the Fire Inspector. Motion made by Hammer, seconded by Gruman to increase the hourly pay rate from \$14/hour to \$16/hour when doing fire inspections. Motion passed on a 4-0 roll call vote.  
Motion made by Gruman, seconded by Shuman to approve the Fire Chief's Report. Motion carried by voice vote.
5. **Police Chief's Report:** The commission reviewed the statistical reports for January 2025 and the Police Chief explained them. The total calls for service in January 2025 was 1687 while in January 2024, there were 1294 calls. Last month, there were 1353 calls. A statistic worth noting is that there was a combined total of 24 deployments in January between the two K9 units. Chief Zilisch also presented and reviewed the 2024 Annual Report to the PFC.

Finally, there was a short ceremony for Officer Bailey and Chief Zilisch for their 20-year and 20+ year careers, respectively, in law enforcement with the City of Mauston. Both received a watch to commemorate the occasion. The PFC congratulates both individuals and thanks both them and their families. Motion made by McGuire, seconded by Gruman to approve the Police Chief's report. Motion carried by voice vote.

- 6. **Adjourn:** Motion by McGuire, seconded by Gruman to adjourn. The motion carried by voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 6:32 p.m.

**OFFICIAL MINUTES OF MEETING  
POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION  
5:30 PM Thursday, September 27, 2018**

**Call to Order/Roll Call**

The Mauston Police and Fire Commission met on Thursday, September 27, 2018, in the Council Chambers of Mauston City Hall. Chair Dan May called the meeting to order at 5:45pm. Members present were Jack Hammer, Pat Miltimore, and May. Members absent were Andy Crandall, Katie Gruman. Also present were Police Chief Mike Zilisch, Fire Chief Kim Hale., Chris Leopold and Mike Petersen of Mauston EMS, and Neil Connors present as the appellant in an Emergency Response Appeal Hearing.

**Minutes**

Miltimore/Hammer to approve the minutes of the July 26, and August 30, 2018, meetings. Motion carried by voice vote.

**Bills**

Miltimore/Hammer to approve the bills for July 2018 and August 2018 as presented. Motion carried by voice vote.

**Fire Chief's Report**

**Emergency Response Appeal Hearing** The PFC Reviewed the Emergency Response Fee documentation and asked Mr. Neil Connors to make a statement for the reason for his appeal. Mr. Connors explained that he has personal, emotional, and financial hardship. After consideration and discussion, there was a motion by May/Hammer to reduce the fee to \$200 and set up a payment plan which will include a payment of \$25/month, due on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of each month, starting on 12/15/2018 until paid in full. Motion passed on a voice vote. Mr. Connors left the meeting after this vote at approximately 6:05 pm.

**July and August Statistical Reports** The calls for service in July and August were reviewed and explained. Chief Hale updated the PFC on the progress of the new Fire Station and its scheduled February 2019 completion. Two additional applications for a fire fighter position were also shared with the PFC.

**Mauston Area Ambulance Association Emergency Response/Dispatch Information** Mr. Leopold and Mr. Petersen presented information to the PFC regarding motor vehicle accidents and requested simultaneous dispatch of the Fire Department and EMS to all motor vehicle accidents.

Miltimore/Hammer to approve simultaneous dispatch of the Fire Department to all EMS calls involving motor vehicle accidents starting October 1, 2018 and lasting for a 6-month trial period. The status of this arrangement will be reviewed in March 2019. Motion passed on a voice vote.

Mr. Petersen and Mr. Leopold also presented a document to be signed by Chief Hale indicating that, starting October 1, 2018, EMS will simultaneously be paged and respond to all structure fires or any other type of working fire as a form of mutual aid to provide medical support as part of a firefighter's rehabilitation services on scene. May/Hammer to approve this arrangement. Motion carried by voice vote. The PFC supports and appreciates this service from Mauston EMS.

Hammer/May to approve the Fire Chief's report. Motion carried by voice vote. Chief Hale left the meeting at 6:45 pm.

**Police Chief's Report**

**Monthly Statistical Report** Chief Zilisch reviewed the July and August 2018 monthly statistical reports and answered questions from the commission members. Hammer/Miltimore to approve the Police Chief's report as presented. Motion carried by voice vote.

**Closed Session**

Hammer/Miltimore to go into closed session pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.85(1)(c). Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote. Commission went into closed session at 6:57pm.
