POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION MINUTES

May 21, 2025 at 5:30 PM

303 Mansion Street Mauston, WI

1. Call to Order/Roll Call:

The Police and Fire Commission met on May 21, 2025, in the Council Chambers of Mauston City Hall. Vice Chair Katie Gruman called the meeting to order at 5:36 p.m. Members present were Jack Hammer, Katie Gruman, Gary Purvis, and Brian McGuire (who arrived at 5:42 p.m.). Deborah Shuman was absent. Also present were Police Chief Mike Zilisch, Fire Chief Brent Lenorud, and City Administrator Daron Haugh.

2. Appointment of Commission Chair:

Motion by Hammer, seconded by Gruman, to close nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Brian McGuire. Motion passed on a voice vote.

3. Appointment of Commission Vice Chair:

Motion by Hammer, seconded by Gruman, to close nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Gary Purvis. Motion passed on a voice vote.

4. Appointment of Commission Secretary:

Motion by McGuire, seconded by Gruman, to close nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Jack Hammer. Motion passed on a voice vote.

5. Minutes:

Motion made by Purvis, seconded by Gruman, to approve the minutes of the April 24, 2025, meeting. Motion passed on a voice vote.

6. Financial Report:

Motion made by Purvis, seconded by Gruman, to approve the Financial Report as presented. Motion passed on a voice vote.

7. Fire Chief's Report:

The April 2025 calls for service were reviewed and explained. Chief Lenorud reported that hose testing has been taking place during meeting nights and that two new firefighter applications were received. He also noted the recent Open House event was well-attended, and positive feedback was received. Motion made by Hammer, seconded by Purvis, to approve the Fire Chief's Report. Motion passed on a voice vote.

8. Police Chief's Report:

- a. Chief Zilisch reviewed the April 2025 statistical report. There were 1,727 total calls for service in April 2025, compared to 1,294 in April 2024 and 1,713 calls last month. Noteworthy statistics included 24 combined K-9 deployments and 57 You Are Not Alone (YANA) contacts. Chief Zilisch also reported that the mental health awareness fundraiser for green badges was successful, raising enough funds for the Mauston Police Department, New Lisbon Police Department, and Juneau County Sheriff's Department so that each could receive the green badges. He mentioned upcoming K-9 fundraising events and noted that the Dunkin' Donuts "Cops on a Rooftop" event raised between \$800-900 for Special Olympics. Motion made by McGuire, seconded by Gruman, to approve the Police Chief's Report. Motion passed on a voice vote.
- b. Recognition of Detective Richard Lueneburg for 20 years of service with the Mauston Police Department.

9. Adjourn:

Motion made by Hammer, seconded by Gruman, to adjourn. Motion passed on a voice vote.

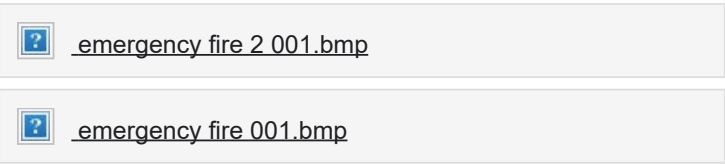

I'd like to appeal the invoice. Whether that be for something as simple as entire invoice waiving, a cost reduction, or even just interest rate removal is all up to you, or the city of mauston, I suppose. I am not sure who makes that decision.

It's not like I can make this incident just go away, so charging interest to an invoice for a past emergent event where no one was injured apart from my own vehicle just seems morally wrong to do, in my opinion.

The reason why I believe it is morally wrong to charge interest is because, essentially, I am being told that I will be charged more if I don't pay on time for a past action that would be considered a city protection..

That's legalized extortion.

Now, the city did put out the fire that I called about. The protection level was met, and I'm grateful, but I just don't have the funds, and almost certainly won't have the amount needed within 90-days, so I'd like to appeal the fee.

I wouldn't say that I'm direly struggling financially, but I'm also definitely not swimming in money by any means. I did have my truck burn down less than two months ago.. which means I needed to buy a new vehicle.. which means I needed to register a new vehicle.. And not to mention all of the property that I had within the vehicle, or that I also have plenty of other financial obligations that have to be met in our damn near collapsing economy.. I know you feel that pain as well when you're standing at the grocery checkout.

I don't make a lot of money.. in fact, I'm barely making it by on \$17.50per hour, but I am, and I would definitely be open to working something out, but it'll take time. Something that is being taken from me.

- (1) The PFC shall hold a hearing within 45 days after receipt of such appeal, and shall give written notice to all interested parties at least ten days prior to such hearing. The chairperson shall administer oaths to all persons providing factual testimony to the PFC and may compel the attendance of any witness by subpoena. The appellant shall attend said hearing in person, and may be represented by counsel. The PFC shall decide all appeals within 30 days after the conclusion of said hearing, and shall transmit a signed copy of its decision to the appellant and all other interested parties. Nothing herein shall limit the PFC from adjourning and continuing the hearing from time to time and place to place for the purpose of accommodating the attendance of interested persons, witnesses, and PFC members, or for the purpose of preparing or presenting additional facts or argument. Moreover, the PFC may adopt such additional procedural rules as it deems necessary to ensure a fair, impartial and expedient hearing on each appeal.
 - (2) The PFC is authorized to waive or replace a fee with an alternative and more appropriate fee based on its review of the evidence. Reasons for a change to the original fee will most likely be based, but not limited to, the following criteria:
 - a. Evidence supports that no service was rendered;
 - b. Evidence supports that the service rendered does not match the applied fee as outlined in the fee schedule;
 - c. No fee on the schedule appropriately matches the service rendered.
 - (3) The decision of the PFC shall be final.
- (i) *Deadlines.* Failure to comply with any of the time periods set forth above shall not invalidate the emergency response fee, nor shall it excuse the responsible person from liability therefor.
