Hello All,

Since our last report the crew has responded to 6 outages, began another line extension on Foreman Road, changed out the defective "blue" lights on Third Street and prepared the city with the holiday decorations.

We had 2 major outages, one that affected the entire town, and the second outage affected customers that are served from the 4KV substation. The first one was due to wind that hit East County hard. The windstorm took out a GHPUD substation high side protection which required the PUD to test their equipment prior to reenergizing. While they were completing their testing, we prepared the city for re-energizing and cleared numerous limbs and trees from the power lines. The second outage that affected our 4KV substation was a very similar type of fault. We lost our high side fusing and before we could reenergize, we needed to have the GHPUD substation crew come and test our substation equipment.

Department Report:

- **Training:**
Officer Owen is currently in his sixth week with the department. His training is progressing well, and he continues to adapt effectively to departmental processes and procedures. He will remain assigned to Officer Campbell for the next few weeks. Officer Campbell has done an excellent job as a trainer and is greatly appreciated.
- **Department Policies:**
Since the department's policies were last established, numerous legal updates have taken place. In response, updated policies have been developed and will be rolled out for the department. While this has been a lengthy process, updates are necessary.
- **Firearms:**
As part of the 2026 department budget, funding was requested and approved for the purchase of new firearms. This request is based on nationwide safety concerns and the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission prohibiting departments from participating in training at their location with our current firearms.

A firearm quote has been attached to this report, and approval from the council is requested to proceed with the purchase. While there will be additional costs associated with holsters, the total expense will remain below the amount budgeted. Once the firearms are ordered, the estimated delivery time is approximately one hundred twenty (120) days.

- Citizen Academy:
We will be partnering with the Elma Police Department, the Grays Harbor County Sheriff's Office, and the Montesano Police Department to offer a Citizens Academy this spring. Additional details will be shared as they become available.

- Code Enforcement:
We will be working with Code Enforcement on compliance and enforcement efforts. Officers working dayshift on Saturday's will be conducting follow-up inspections related to code enforcement cases and issuing infractions when necessary.

Water and Wastewater:

As many of you are aware we had a lot of rain here in McCleary during the month of December. From December 1 to December 31, we had 20.14 inches of rain. For the Aquifer that's great! We have plenty of water available!

For the Wastewater Treatment plant, it is not so great! During the dry season we receive 65-100 gpm into the treatment plant. At times, during the big rain events, we had 700-1100gpm. The Wastewater Treatment Plant was able to handle the excess flows; we just spent more money treating rainwater.

My big concern was that Sam's canal might flood the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Where the flow comes out of the culvert after 7th Ave, Sam's canal was going over its banks. This is in part due to no one keeping the canal clean for at least 15 years. If flows had continued and the canal had flooded the WWTP, we would have all sorts of problems, including environmental and financial costs.

Thank you for requesting my assistance with your accounting needs. The purpose of this letter is to outline the services to be provided and give you an estimate of the time it will take.

You have requested that I assist the City of McCleary by providing technical accounting assistance on an as-needed basis.

My Responsibilities

The objective of the engagement is to apply accounting and financial reporting expertise to assist you with assigned projects and tasks.

I will conduct the engagement in accordance with Statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services promulgated by the Accounting and Review Services Committee of the AICPA and comply with the AICPA's *Code of Professional Conduct*, including the ethical principles of integrity, objectivity, professional competence and due care.

The engagement cannot be relied upon to identify or disclose any financial statement misstatements, including those caused by fraud or error, or to identify or disclose any wrongdoing within the city or noncompliance with laws or regulations. However, I will inform you of any material errors or evidence of fraud that come to my attention during the engagement. In addition, I will inform you of any evidence or information that comes to my attention during the preparation process regarding any wrongdoing within the city or noncompliance with laws and regulations that may have occurred, unless they are clearly inconsequential. I have no responsibility to identify and communicate deficiencies or material weakness in your internal control as part of this engagement.

Your Responsibilities

The engagement to be performed is conducted on the basis that you acknowledge and understand that my responsibility is to assist you with accounting and financial reporting. You have the following overall responsibilities that are fundamental to my undertaking the engagement in accordance with Statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services:

1. The prevention and detection of fraud.
2. To ensure that the city complies with the laws and regulations applicable to its activities.
3. The accuracy and completeness of the records, documents, explanations, and other information, including significant judgements, you provide to me for the engagement.

Other Relevant Information

I am solely responsible for performing the engagement. Work will be performed primarily from my home office, with visits to your office as needed. Fees for these services will be based on the actual time spent at an hourly rate of \$205/hour. Actual hours worked and billed shall not exceed 120 hours or \$24,600. Travel to city offices will be billed in addition, at a rate of \$250 per day. The fee estimate is based on anticipated cooperation from your personnel and the assumption that unexpected circumstances will not be encountered during the work performed. If significant additional time is necessary, I will discuss it with you and arrive at a new fee estimate before additional costs are incurred. Invoices for these fees will be rendered each month as work progresses and are payable within 30 days. This agreement shall expire December 31st, 2026.

I appreciate the opportunity to be of service to you and believe this letter accurately summarizes the significant terms of the engagement. If you have any questions, please let me know.
