Background

Following the November 12th, 2025 Board of Commissioners meeting, staff were directed to move forward with a more detailed analysis of the structural components connecting the structure to the foundation. To begin this assessment, the connections need to be exposed for visual assessment via removal of the existing subflooring and/or the removal of sand from beneath the structure. These two options were issued as bid requests to all responsive bidders who previously provided a repair bid. The first option involved removing the interior floor system, including both the tile and subfloor. The second option required the removal of approximately 133.33 cubic yards of sand.

Staff received bids from Quality Restoration & Renovations and from Mali Contracting Corp.

In addition, to better understand if sand removal was a viable option, staff reached out to a local vacuum/pumping vendor for a professional opinion and budget estimate. For informational purposes, their response has been attached.

Snack Shack Subfloor and Tile Removal - Bid Specification Sheet

- ** Option 1- Removal and disposal of approximately 1,800 square feet of subfloor and tile at the Snack Shack to prepare surface for future flooring installation.

- Use dust control methods (HEPA vacuums, water misting) to minimize airborne particles.
- Clean and prepare exposed substrate for future installation (option 1 only).
- Remove all tools, debris, and restore work area to a clean, safe condition upon completion.

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

Subject: ITB #25-14 Johns Pass Dredging

Background

City staff responded to requests from Johns Pass business owners to address the sand accumulation in Johns Pass as it was believed to be negatively impacting business operations, increasing flooding and damaging infrastructure. While all dates and conversations associated with the evolution of this project are not readily known by current staff, we offer the following key dates of early action and subsequent project phases:

- <u>September 2, 2022</u> The City received a proposal for "Johns Pass Dredging Design, Permitting, and Pre-Construction Services" from Aptim Environmental & Infrastructure, LLC for a lump sum value of \$136,727.00
- February 8, 2023 The sitting City manager signed an FDEP Standard Grant Agreement for "Madeira Beach John's Pass North Shoreline Dredging". The grant work plan stated, in part "A significant amount of sand accumulation at the inlet has led to localized flooding that has damaged infrastructure, threatened public safety, and cost the City of Madeira Beach a loss in valuable tourism dollars. Additionally, the same amount of water traveling through a narrower inlet has increased threats from the increased power of the currents posing significant public risks to recreational swimmers and commercial boaters." With this the grant goes on to state, "The City will dredge a portion of John's Pass inlet. The project will remove sand accumulation on the north side of John's Pass inlet and the northern shoal" The grant was awarded in the amount of \$1,556,000 and has a current expiration date of December 31, 2026. The grant includes costs associated with: Pre-Design Study, Preconstruction activities, Bidding & Contractor Selection, Construction and Study, with each task having a budgetary line item amount.
- <u>Design & Permitting Phase</u> The plans were completed and utilized to apply for all necessary permits from: FDEP, Army Corp, FDOT, Pinellas County and the City. During the design process it was determined the sand recovered from dredging may not meet the necessary requirements for beach renourishment but instead would need to be disposed of in a qualifying landfill. Since then, the city has purchased a 4.5 acre parcel which could receive the sand for use in grading and site elevation. In addition, by utilizing the sand within the city limits disposal costs could be reduced, however with this change the permits must be updated to reflect the sand disposal proposal. The status of permits are as follows:

FDEP – Permit Approved and waiting on modification to permit for the disposal to be changed to 555 150th Ave.

Army Corp – Permit Approved waiting on moficiation to permit for the disposal to be changed to 555 150th The.

FDOT - Permit was required for Right-Of-Way access and has been approved.

Pinellas County – Submitted reflecting the city owned parcel as a disposal site and is under review. Site Inspection scheduled for December 11, 2025.

 Construction Bids – The construction bid was broadcast via Demand Star (ITB-25-14-0-2026/MW) on October 7, 2025 with a due date of November 21, 2025. As noted above during that time frame the city secured a 4.5-acre parcel where the dredged sand could be placed. Following the original broadcast, an addendum was posted to request an alternate bid that included disposing the sand on the 4.5 acre parcel. The city received three contractor bid proposals:

Fiscal Impact

As awarded, the grant has a construction budgetary line item task estimate of \$1,300,000 of the awarded \$1,556,000. City staff is reviewing expenditures across all grant line items to determine how much has been spent and whether the remaining funds will fully cover construction and any other remaining tasks. A financial update will be provided at the meeting

Recommendation(s)

Staff recommends the Board of Commissioners consider the quote from Bayside Dredging LLC as they were deemed to be the most responsive and compliant with bid requirements.

If an invoice fails to meet the contract requirements by, among other things, failing to provide the date(s) of service, the materials used, and other details sufficient to verify the work and its related costs, the City will reject the invoice within 20 days after it is received. Any such rejection will be in writing and will specify the deficiencies and what information or changes are required to make the invoice proper. Payment of corrected, accepted invoices will be within 10 business days from the invoiced City's receipt of same unless City Commission approval is required. Any portion of an invoice covering Work or materials which are disputed by the invoiced City in terms of quality, quantity, workmanship or defective installation shall be disputed by the City in accordance with Florida Statutes § 218.76(2). However, any portion of an invoice covering Work or materials which are not disputed will be paid within the time periods set forth herein.
