Morgan Stanley discussed the asset allocation sheet, percentage of portfolio and differences to policy target. The total assets as of October 10, 2022 were \$15,459,685 and \$15,255,394 as of September 30, 2022. The quarter end return was -4.92% compared to -4.31% benchmark, one-year out was -16.3% compared to -18.38% benchmark, and up 5.03% 5-years to date compared to 4.08% benchmark.
