MEETING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC:

There were no members of the public wishing to speak.

REPORTS:

Finance Report

Director Tucker reported to the membership that Tony Austin has completed promotional videos for Cadillac Straits and Diamond Jims and has submitted paid invoices from each of these businesses. A total of \$832 has been paid for four (4) marketing videos through our partnership with 1 Vision Media.

Director Tucker noted that \$350 was paid for the renewal of our membership to the Michigan Downtowns Association. Membership renewals now run from October to October each year. The MDA is now basing dues owned moving forward and ours are based on the total budget of the DDA. I have attached the invoice.

11 Mile Streetscape Project Update

Director Tucker stated that the MSOC Placemaking Grant Quarterly Reporting Completed. The first quarter of grant reporting for the Placemaking Grant was submitted on 1/27 for the 1/31 deadline. No grant spending was reported in this period, but activities including preparations for the ITB were described and their costs will be reported next at the next reporting period.

Director Tucker updated the membership on the Invitation to Bid preparation, noting that all open questions that may impact the ITB package have been resolved, and details of the landscaping plan are finalized. Nowak Fraus anticipates that the ITB will be ready to post onto MITN on Wednesday February 19th.

Director Tucker advised the membership that City staff met with the owners of U-Haul and legal Counsel on January 16th. While they express a little dissatisfaction with the change in traffic circulation on their site, their primary concern that they would be losing private property to eminent domain was alleviated. A Meeting with Charles Laurencelle at 515 E 11 Mile Rd was held over Teams on Jan. 30th about changes to his private parking lot and whether he'd prefer to access his lot through the alley or with a new approach on Delton. This opened a greater conversation about vacating the alleyway, as it is the only city maintained alleyway in the project area and that if we granted an easement for the businesses or allowed them to take over the property, it would relieve the city of the maintenance costs, reduce the project costs (no need to build approach) and allow 515 E 11 Mile to keep all of their private parking. He is waiting for advice from the City Attorney

as to the pros and cons of vacating this alley or granting an easement to the property owners and how to go about it.

Director Tucker updated the Board on the progress on United Methodist Church Sign for ROW: He has learned that our electrical inspector will not require an electrical contractor for the sign replacement provided that the sign contractor uses the existing conduit that is underground and being used for the sign. Avoiding the need for an electrical contractor will significantly reduce costs for the project. If the electrical conduit is rusted out or any unforeseen issues that require an electrical contractor, the City will find a separate contractor. Thus far he has requested quotes from Johnson Signs, Curb Appeal Concepts and Signarama.

Update on Ongoing Projects:

MHDDA Business Digital Marketing Program Update

Payment has been sent to 1 Vision Media for the completion of two more promotional videos, one for Diamond Jim's and another for Cadillac Straits.

Streetlight/Holiday Decorations

The Design Committee has a holiday catalog, a map of all the existing streetlight locations as well as the most recent MKSK landscaping plan that shows the new streetlight locations in relation to all the other improvements made for the project. All these should provide a starting point for planning any additions to our holiday decoration plans for this year.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Promotions Committee - Member Sheppard reported that the committee would like to work on social media videos for the 11 Mile Streetscape.

TRAINING & EVENT OPPORTUNITIES:

Director Tucker noted that the Michigan Downtown Association will be having their spring workshop in March, and he will email the membership with the information. In addition, Oakland County Mainstreet will be hosting an event that highlights DDAs in June.

MHHP Director Williams stated that some of the upcoming events include "How to Connect with Influencers" and the State of the Cities. More information is available in the newsletter.

Member Sheppard noted that the Green Crawl will be similar to last year, and they are finalizing the paperwork for the event.

Subject Downtown Banners

Winter Banners

The Design Committee met on Feb. 24th to make recommendations on the quantity and theme of additional seasonal banners and to discuss options for holiday decorations. At this meeting, it was decided that these new banners and decorations would ben used in the downtown core: Palmer to Lorenz on 11 Mie and University to Greig on John R. The committee estimated that this would require (34) banners.

Additionally, a winter and a fall banner were selected from a catalog. After this meeting, further discussion happened via email and in other committees and a few other winter banner designs were suggested and it the consensus to not include a fall banner. The designs that were picked ultimately come from the same supplier "Consort" so I believe that all the bidding company can fulfil a design for them. I have included the first banner that was chosen and two more circled on a catalog page of more winter designs. Just in case, we should pick a first and second choice.

The lowest bidding company is Banner Sign Co. in Detroit. If the board selects a banner that has room for a custom message, this will increase the banner costs. Banner Sign Co. said that adding a custom design would be \$50 to the total order.

Staff Recommended Action:

It is recommended that the DDA board not include a custom message in the banner because the text will be difficult to notice due to the banner size on a 25ft pole. It is further recommended that the DDA board pick a first and second choice of banner. Finally, it is recommended that the DDA board authorize staff to purchase (34) winter banners from the lowest of the three quoting companies. The cost is expected to be \$2,951.40, but staff asks they are authorized to spend up to \$3,500 to account for customization of banner or other unanticipated costs.



Subject Holiday Decorations

Included with this memo is pricing for new snowflake decorations from four different companies and the costs from Bronner's to refurbish an equivalent amount of our existing holiday decorations by comparison. The challenge with this purchase is that aside from the "Silhouette" style snowflake, each company is selling a different design, so cost comparisons aren't one to one. Further, Bronner's did not provide a cost for the shipping for the refurbishing option in time for this packet, so it is not clear precisely what total costs would be in comparison.

Now that we have pricing options for new decorations and one example of the cost of refurbishing our existing decorations we need to decide if we still want to incur these costs, whether we want to refurbish or buy new and if we are buying new, what design we want to move forward with. Our current budget has \$20,000 remaining for "Improvements" less anything spent on banners. Any remaining costs beyond this would be carried over into our next Fiscal Year Improvements line item.



The unit cost of these bike racks is \$329, for a total of \$3,948 plus shipping. The more products that are ordered from a single company, the greater savings in shipping we may have.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Based on discussions had individually and at committee meetings prior to the DDA meeting of April 17th, the consensus on the preferred benches seems to be the "Curved Back Black Powder Coated" bench by the company ThePark. The unit cost of these bike racks is \$709, for a total of \$6,381 plus shipping. The more products that are ordered from a single company, the greater savings in shipping we may have.





Included with this memo is a summary of these bins including what they look like and their features. The "Plaza" bin by Uline doesn't have an option with a rain bonnet. Uline's "Courtyard" is quoted above with the bonnet but is available without it for modest savings per unit. All these options are powdered coated steel.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the MHDDA select the "Executive" trash bin with rain bonnet and door by the company ThePark for the unit price of \$787.00 per bin. The rain-bonnet cuts down on the amount of water that would get into the bin, less wet trash is better. Adding a door to the bin makes it a lot easier for the trash to be removed, opposed to lifting the bonnet and top off and pulling the trash out from the top. The more products that are ordered from a single company, the greater savings in shipping we may have.

Beauty Room 11 was founded in downtown Madison Heights in 2019 located at 925 W 11 Mile Rd, where it was operated until 2023. At this time Tatiana closed her business following the birth of her daughter. After a brief time in another location outside of the city, Beauty Room 11 returned to the DDA area at 25616 John R Rd in January 2025. On March 14th, Tatiana submitted a Sign Grant application along with three quotes she had gathered for signage on her John R facing frontage. The application is requesting a match for \$2000 for a \$4000 backlit wall sign.

Design Committee Recommendation:

The Economic Vitality Committee met on 3-26-25 to discuss this Sign Grant application. After review, the committee recommended that this grant request be approved for up to 50% of the total project cost or \$2,000, whichever is less with the following conditions:

- Upon first reviewing her application staff discovered that the proposed signage exceeded the maximum size allowed based on the 20ft frontage. Provide a revised quote and sign plan including dimensions and material that meets all requirements of local sign ordinances.
- 2. The applicant was able to open in February with a temporary certificate of occupancy with the understanding that business parking space striping would be complete when weather permits. Complete striping and obtain a certificate of occupancy.
- 3. While the applicant has operated their business in downtown Madison Heights in the past, they have not been in continuous operation at this location. For this reason, the Economic Vitality Committee recommends that the project be reimbursed for the project once you have reached one continuous year at this location (February 4, 2026).

Staff concur with this recommendation. The applicant understands that they will only be reimbursed for this project after it is completed, inspected, demonstrated that the contractor has been paid, and that the business has been in continuous operation for at least one year.

Giles, I am so sorry I have not gotten back to you sooner but we had a large install yesterday both inside and outside of a

building and had some difficulty due to the weather and we had to go back today to finish it. I agree that the descriptions for the type of signs are very vague. Maybe suggest that with the sign grant application there

needs to be a detailed description of the sign construction and materials.

The first one from Sign Master

is a box sign backlit with LED lights vinyl surface with polycarbonate plastic (which is much stronger than acrylic

and will not crack or break if hit with something in a storm) andmore expensive.than acrylic. The description will give the

look of 3-D letters that will glow from the sides as well as the face of the letters themselves but with a flat face.

It also looks like this is the cost including installation. The \$4000 is a fair cost.

The second one from FS Signs is over the top.

It is a molded pan face which is usually not done. It looks like a blow mold lawn figure that you see at the holidays.

It stands about 3-4" from the face of the box sign structure and the letters protrude even slightly more. There is only one

manufacturer of this type of face in Michigan and they are in Big Rapids.

They also are going to add the permit fees on the top of it

The 3rd estimate from A1 Signs is similar or the same as the quote from Sign Master but the cost is \$800 more.

Lexan and polycarbonate are the same material.

Please make sure that any estimate includes UL approved lighting and the UL sticker is on the sign itself. Also that

the sign will be installed by a licensed and insured company.

Please let me know if there is anything else that I could help you with.

Subject: 11 Mile Streetscape Project Update

11 Mile Streetscape Project Phase I Updates

- <u>1.</u> City Council Awards 11 Mile Streetscape Project Phase I to DiLisio Contracting 3-24-25: The lowest responsible bidder DiLisio Contracting was awarded the contract for the Streetscape project at the 3-24-25 City council meeting with a construction cost of \$888,953.00. A pre-construction meeting is anticipated to take place mid to late April. At this meeting the details of the project, including its timeline, any lane closures or other phases will be finalized, allowing us to in turn communicate these details to all affected businesses and property owners.
- 2. United Methodist Church Sign & ROW Purchase Agreement: A draft property transfer agreement and Quit Claim Deed have been sent over to the church for review. Once approved, we will enter into an agreement with Signarama Clinton Township for the demo and replacement of the church sign. The foundation of the old sign will be left in place and DiLisio Contracting will either ensure that it is not a tripping hazard or remove the foundation from the ROW for an additional cost. A cost estimate for the removal of the foundation will be developed as we are closer to our preconstruction meeting.
- 3. 515 E. 11 Mile Rd- Charles Laurencelle: A draft easement agreement document has been sent to the owner of 515 E 11 Mile Rd for review. The owner of 515 E 11 Mile said that he would prefer that the 11 Mile Streetscape not construct an approach on Delton into his parking lot, as it would reduce his parking space by 2 spaces. Instead, it has been agreed that we would record an access easement to the property owner on the portion of the alleyway going into the site with the conditions that the property owner maintains this portion of the alleyway including the approach and that in the event this arrangement doesn't work the at the City provide an approach on Delton.
- <u>4.</u> <u>241 E 11 Mile R Rd:</u> On 4-8 I met on site with the property owners to discuss traffic circulation, striping and a potential Sign Grant application.

SUBJECT: 11 Mile Streetscape Groundbreaking & Grand Opening

There has been interested in a groundbreaking ceremony as well as some sort of Grand Opening type event celebrating the completion of the streetscape once completed. In general, we could hold a groundbreaking event in mid to late June, and a grand opening event as early as mid-October. We will be able to narrow down to specific dates after the entire construction schedule is set at the pre-construction meeting, which is typically held about 3 weeks prior to the beginning of the project. All concrete work and landscaping should be installed by October. However, all the ROW will be recently seeded and probably muddy, so it may be wise to hold an event the following Spring.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that we schedule a groundbreaking ceremony with DDA, City Council, Main Street Oakland County and invite local media once we know the start of construction. Further, staff and the promotions committee should meet to discuss and plan a downtown event that showcases the streetscape project and downtown businesses.

Subject: Brownfield Project Updates

1. Madison Center Owner

- 29411 John R Rd: A temporary certificate of occupancy was issued on 3-17-25 to Kim Nhung Superfood Inc., a grand opening ceremony is scheduled for Saturday April 19th at 10am.
- 29345 John R Rd (Outlot): The outlot space has been sold to PMF JOHN R LLC for the development of Popeyes. Engineering was submitted and tentatively approved but their fees remain unpaid. Speaking with their engineer Popeyes is contemplating a new design and this has delayed development. Because of this delay, the project will be subject to our new zoning ordinance.
- 2. **Hudson-Madison LLC:** Project complete. No new developments
- 3. **Woodward Holdings LLC:** This is the site of the former Active Adult Center. Phase I & Phase II environmental, demolition, fencing and underground utility work has been conducted on site for Car Wash Development. Tommy's has since backed out of the project, but another car wash developer is anticipated to take its place using the sign configuration and building envelope.
- 4. **Brownfield TIF Application & Guidelines Update:** New inquiries on our brownfield TIF application have prompted me to consider revising our application, eligibility requirements and guidelines. I anticipate presenting a new application and guidelines for consideration at our August 21st joint meeting.
