BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$340,000 FOR VARIOUS PARK ACQUISITIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS BY AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$255,000 IN BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP FOR FINANCING PART OF THE APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

The improvements described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance (the "Improvements") are hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Township of Middletown, New Jersey (the "Township") as a general improvement. For the said Improvements there is hereby appropriated the amount of \$340,000, such sum includes the sum of \$85,000 expected to be received as a grant from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection - Green Acres. No down payment is required by the Local Bond Law of the State of New Jersey, constituting Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes, as amended and supplemented (the "Local Bond Law") as the purpose authorized herein is in connection with improvements funded by a State Grant from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection - Green Acres as permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-11c.

SECTION 2:

In order to finance the cost of the Improvements not covered by the grant, negotiable bonds of the Township are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount of \$255,000 pursuant to the provisions of the Local Bond Law (the "Bonds"). In anticipation of the issuance of the Bonds and to temporarily finance said improvements or purposes, negotiable bond anticipation notes of the Township are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount not exceeding \$255,000 pursuant to the provisions of the Local Bond Law (the "Bond Anticipation Notes" or "Notes").

SECTION 3:

- (a) The Improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which obligations are to be issued is for various park acquisitions and improvements, including but not limited for Tindall Park, including resurfacing of tennis courts, site clearing, tree removal, adding of benches, bike racks and picnic tables, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.
- (b) The estimated maximum amount of Bonds or Notes to be issued for the purpose of financing a portion of the cost of the Improvements is \$255,000.
- (c) The estimated cost of the Improvements is \$340,000, which amount represents the initial appropriation made by the Township.

SECTION 4:

All Bond Anticipation Notes issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by the chief financial officer of the Township (the "Chief Financial Officer"); provided that no Note shall mature later than one year from its date. The Notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and be in such form as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer. The Chief Officer shall determine all matters in connection with Notes issued pursuant to this ordinance, and the signature of the Chief Financial Officer upon the Notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. All Notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of Section 8(a) of the Local Bond Law. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the Notes from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver them to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the date of delivery thereof. The Chief Financial Officer is directed to report in writing to the governing body of the Township at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the Notes pursuant to this ordinance is made. Such report must include the amount, the description, the interest rate and the maturity schedule of the Notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

SECTION 5:

The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs, State of New Jersey is on file with the Township Clerk and is available for public inspection.

SECTION 6:

The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

- (a) The Improvements described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance are not current expenses, and are capital improvements or properties that the Township may lawfully make or acquire as general improvements, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefited thereby.
- (b) The average period of usefulness of the Improvements, within the limitations of the Local Bond Law, taking into consideration the respective amounts of all obligations authorized for the several purposes, according to the reasonable life thereof computed from the date of the Bonds authorized by this bond ordinance, is 15 years.
- (c) The Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly prepared and filed in the office of the Township Clerk and a complete executed duplicate thereof has been filed in the office of the Director, Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs, State of New Jersey. Such statement shows that the gross debt of the Township, as defined in the Local Bond Law, is increased by the authorization of the Bonds and Notes provided in this bond ordinance by \$255,000 and the obligations authorized herein will be within all debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.

(d) An aggregate amount not exceeding \$50,000 for items of expense listed in and permitted under Section 20 of the Local Bond Law is included in the estimated cost of the Improvements, as indicated herein.

SECTION 7:

Any funds received from time to time by the Township as contributions in aid of financing the purposes described in Section 3 of this Ordinance shall be used for financing said Improvements by application thereof either to direct payment of the cost of said Improvements or to the payment or reduction of the authorization of the obligations of the Township authorized therefor by this Bond Ordinance. Any such funds received may, and all such funds so received which are not required for direct payment of the cost of said Improvements shall, be held and applied by the Township as funds applicable only to the payment of obligations of the Township authorized by this Bond Ordinance.

SECTION 8:

The full faith and credit of the Township are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the obligations authorized by this bond ordinance. The obligations shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Township, and the Township shall be obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable property within the Township for the payment of the obligations and the interest thereon without limitation of rate or amount.

SECTION 9:

The Chief Financial Officer of the Township is hereby authorized to prepare and to update from time to time as necessary a financial disclosure document to be distributed in connection with the sale of obligations of the Township and to execute such disclosure document on behalf of the Township. The Chief Financial Officer is further authorized to enter into the appropriate undertaking to provide secondary market disclosure on behalf of the Township pursuant to Rule 15c2-12 of the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Rule") for the benefit of holders and beneficial owners of obligations of the Township and to amend such undertaking from time to time in connection with any change in law, or interpretation thereof, provided such undertaking is and continues to be, in the opinion of a nationally recognized bond counsel, consistent with the requirements of the Rule. In the event that the Township fails to comply with its undertaking, the Township shall not be liable for any monetary damages, and the remedy shall be limited to specific performance of the undertaking.

SECTION 10:

This Bond Ordinance constitutes a declaration of official intent under Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2. The Township reasonably expects to pay expenditures with respect to the Improvements prior to the date that Township incurs debt obligations under this Bond Ordinance. The Township reasonably expects to reimburse such expenditures with the proceeds of debt to be incurred by the Township under this Bond Ordinance. The maximum principal amount of debt expected to be issued for payment of the costs of the Improvements is \$255,000.

SECTION 11:

This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.

TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 41 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN GOVERNING OFFICERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN

WHEREAS, the Township of Middletown (the "<u>Township</u>") has an all-volunteer fire department consisting of eleven individual fire companies (the "<u>Fire Department</u>"); and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has requested that the Township Committee amend the provisions of the Township Code relating to the eligibility requirements for line officers found in § 41-7 of the Township Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that § 41 of the Code of the Township of Middletown be and is hereby amended and supplemented, as follows:

SECTION 1. Amendment of § 41-7

§ 41-7. Eligibility requirements for line officers.

A. To be eligible for nomination to the office of Chief, Deputy Chief, First Assistant Chief, Second Assistant Chief or Third Assistant Chief (collectively referred to as the "Officers"), a nominee shall have served as an active fireman firefighter in the Township for five years next preceding his their election and prior to his their nomination shall have served and fully completed a one-year term as Captain of one of the companies of the Department.

The nominee shall also have obtained, prior to being nominated to serve as an Officer, an Incident Management Level 3 Certification issued by the New Jersey Division of Fire Safety and shall have successfully completed a New Jersey Fire Officer Level 1 Course meeting the requirements of the NFPA 1021, an Incident Safety Officer Course and the 12-hour Principles of Building Construction Course. In addition, any nominee for an Officer position shall have met the LOSAP qualifying criteria for three (3) years preceding the nomination.

The eligibility requirements to serve as an Officer shall take effect four years following the adoption of the ordinance establishing said requirements by the Township Committee (the "Exemption Period"). All Officers serving on the date of adoption of the ordinance establishing these eligibility requirements shall be exempt from said requirements during the Exemption Period.

The Middletown Township Fire Academy shall offer all or part of the courses required to serve as an Officer during each semester on a rotating basis so that over a four year period all of the required courses are offered. If a member cannot complete any of the required courses at either the Middletown Township Fire Academy or the Monmouth County Fire Academy during a four year period, then the Fire Department shall reimburse the member for the cost of tuition and books from another recognized in-state training agency.

B. The Chief, Deputy Chief, First Assistant Chief, Second Assistant Chief and Third Assistant Chief shall each be members of different companies. In no case shall any two or more of said officers be active members of the same company.

SECTION 2. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Severability.

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, adoption and publication in the manner prescribed by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-3331

TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF TEXAS AVENUE WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN

WHEREAS, the vacation of a public street, or part, thereof, which has not been opened by the municipality, may be authorized by the municipal governing body by ordinance pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:67-19, <u>et seq.</u>, when there is no longer any need for the use of said area by the public; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Middletown (the "<u>Township</u>") has determined that a portion of Texas Avenue, as shown on the official tax map of the Township, is not needed for any public purposes, and that the public interest would be best served by vacating and extinguishing all public right, title and interest in and to that portion of Texas Avenue, so that the underlying lands may be combined with, and become and form part of, adjacent properties; and

WHEREAS, the area of Texas Avenue to be vacated (the "<u>Subject Area</u>") consists of approximately 1,386 square feet, and is located adjacent to Block 234, Lot 8; and

WHEREAS, the Subject Area is properly depicted on a survey prepared by Thomas Finnegan Land Surveying, dated August 6, 2021, a copy of which is attached hereto as "<u>Exhibit A</u>" and made a part hereof, and is more particularly described in a legal description attached hereto as "<u>Exhibit B</u>" and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Township that once the Subject Area has been vacated, the ownership of the underlying real property shall revert to the adjoining property owners of the adjacent Block 234, Lot 8 by operation of law subject to proposed Sanitary Sewer and Drainage Easements as further described in "**Exhibit C**" attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee believes that the vacation of all public right, title and interest in and to in the Subject Area, is in the best interests of the Township, as well as the adjacent property owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-19, et seq., the Township hereby vacates, extinguishes, releases and abandons all public right, title and interest in and to an unpaved portion of Texas Avenue, which is located immediately adjacent to Block 234, Lot 8, as more particularly shown on Exhibit A attached hereto, and as more particularly described in Exhibit B attached hereto.
- 2. It is the intention of the Township that once the subject area has been vacated, then ownership of the underlying lands shall revert to the owners of the adjacent properties by operation of law subject to Sanitary Sewer and Drainage Easements, as further described in Exhibit C attached hereto.
- 3. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall not be deemed to vacate any rights and privileges which may be possessed by any public utility company under N.J.S.A. 48:2-13, or by any cable television company under N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1, et seq., to maintain, repair, and replace any existing facilities in, adjacent to, over or under the vacated Subject Area.
- 4. Following the introduction of this Ordinance, the Township Clerk shall provide notice of its pending status as mandated by N.J.S.A. 40:49-6, and

at least one week prior to the time fixed for further consideration and final passage of the Ordinance the Township Clerk shall mail a copy of the Ordinance, together with a notice of the introduction thereof, and information as to the time and place of when and where the Ordinance will be further considered for final passage, to every person whose lands may be affected by the Ordinance, by certified mail return receipt requested and regular mail, to their last known post office addresses.

- 5. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-21, following the adoption of this Ordinance, the Township Clerk shall within 60 days of the effective date thereof, file a copy of this Ordinance along with the attached exhibits, certified by the clerk, under the seal of the Township, to be a true and exact copy of the Ordinance, together with a copy of the proof of publication thereof, in the Office of the Monmouth County Clerk for recordation in the County's Book of Vacations.
- 6. The Mayor, Township Administrator, Township Clerk, Township Attorney and Township Engineer are hereby authorized and directed to undertake all actions and to prepare all documents that are necessary in order to effectuate the intentions of this Ordinance.
- 7. That all costs and expenses associated with this matter shall be the responsibility of the owner of Block 234, Lot 8, and sufficient funding shall be posted by said property owner prior to the adoption of the within Ordinance in order to cover all the Township's expenses associated with this matter.
- 8. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable. In the event that any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such judgement shall be limited in its effect only to the portion of the Ordinance actually adjudged invalid and shall not be deemed to affect the operation of any other portion thereof, which shall remain in full force and effect.
- 9. That all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
- 10. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.

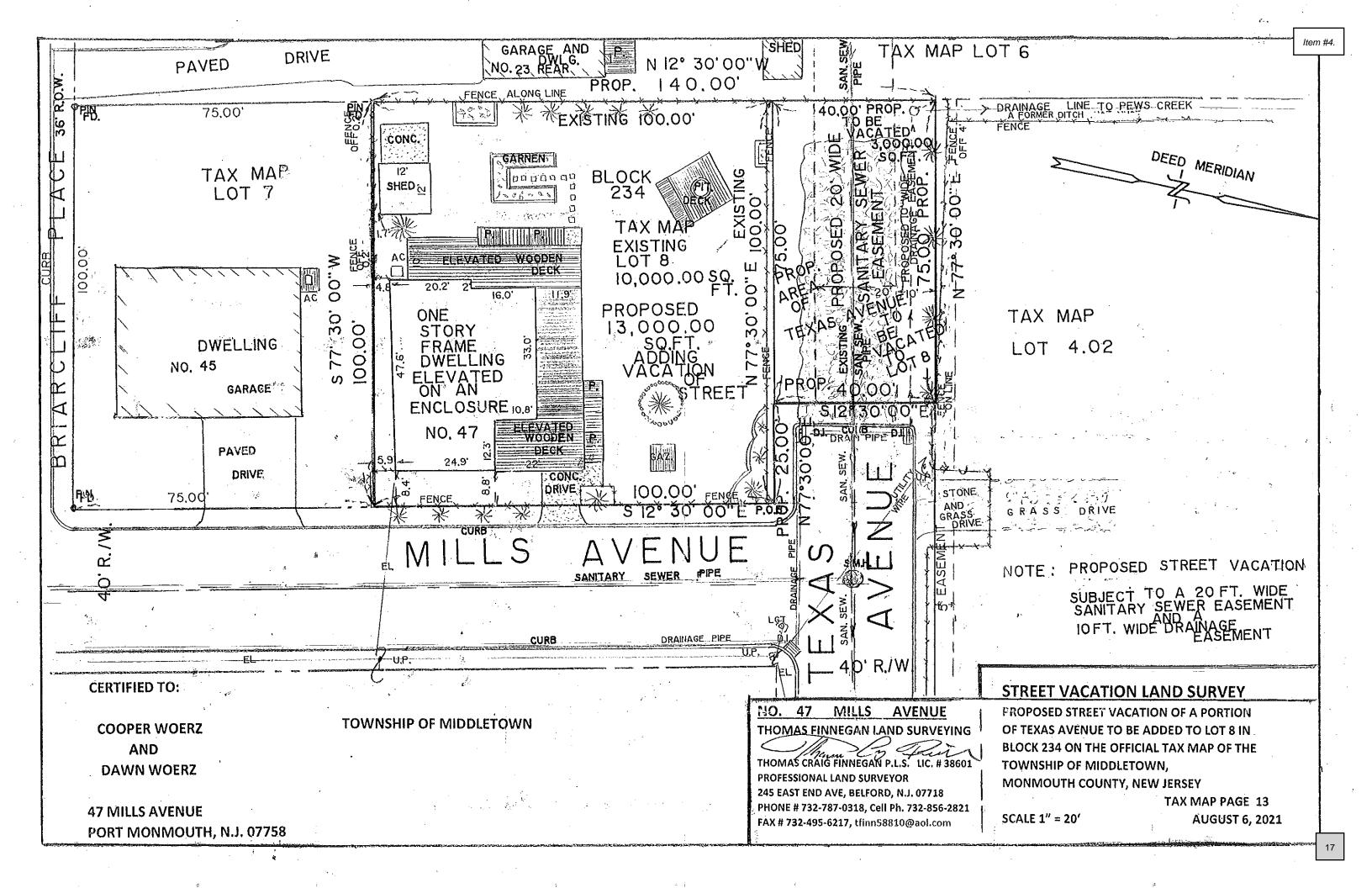

WHEREAS, the USACE's investigation resulted in the Raritan Bay and Sandy Hook Bay, Port Monmouth Feasibility Report for Hurricane and Storm Damage Reduction (the "Feasibility Report") dated September 25, 2000; and

WHEREAS, under Section 101 of the Water Resources Development Act of 2000, and based on the Feasibility Report, the United States Congress authorized a hurricane and storm damage reduction project in the Raritan Bay and Sandy Hook Bay, Port Monmouth, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the County has instituted an Integrated Pest Management Program consisting of surveillance, water management, biological control, and chemical control to exterminate the mosquito population within the County of Monmouth; and

WHEREAS, prior to conducting aerial dispensing operations over a designated "congested area," the County is required, pursuant to Federal Aviation Administration Regulation (FAR Part 137.51), to secure prior written approval from the governing body of the political subdivision over which the aircraft is to be operated; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Middletown is designated as a "congested area" by the Federal Aviation Administration and the County has requested that this governing body consent to its proposed aerial dispensing operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

- 1. The Governing Body hereby authorizes the County of Monmouth Mosquito Control Division or its agent to apply pesticides by aircraft for mosquito control in certain areas of the municipality designated by the County as being either larval mosquito habitat or area harboring high populations of mosquitoes constituting either a nuisance, a health hazard, or both with the understanding that:
 - The County shall utilize pesticides, application equipment and aircraft that are approved for aerial application by the applicable Federal (USEPA) and State (NJDEP) agencies, and
 - b. such operations will be performed in compliance with applicable Federal and State regulations, and
 - c. the County will notify the police department of each municipality over which aerial pesticide operations are planned prior to commencement of such operations.

TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TAX COLLECTOR TO RECEIVE PROPERTY TAX PAYMENTS ONLINE AND AWARDING CONTRACT TO EDMUNDS GOVTECH

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:5-43 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 5:30-9.1 et seq., the Township of Middletown (the "Township") is authorized to accept credit card payments for most obligations payable to the municipality; and

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2021, the Township adopted Resolution No. 21-127, which authorized the Township to accept payments for general fees established by ordinance that are payable to the Township using credit cards, debit cards, and/or electronic funds transfers; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector has recommend utilizing the service FIS Pay Direct Solutions in association with Edmunds Govtech WIPP Program to process online tax payments, which is compatible to the current tax collection software utilized by the Township Tax Collector and is provided by the same vendor; and

WHEREAS, the Township has reviewed and determined that the total estimated value of the proposed arrangement is less than the bid threshold, and therefore the necessary amendment to the existing agreement with Edmunds Govtech for this concession-based service may be awarded by informal quotation, as provided in N.J.A.C. 5:34-9.4(f) and (g).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated as if set forth at length herein.
- 2. The Township hereby authorizes the acceptance of credit card payment for property taxes through the FIS Pay Direct Solutions in association with Edmunds Govtech WIPP Program (the "Program") beginning on February 23, 2022.
- 3. The Township hereby approves the award of a contract to Edmunds Govtech to utilize the Program for a period of 12 months pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:5-43 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 5:30-9.1 et seq.
- 4. The Mayor and Township Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all agreements as necessary to effectuate the foregoing, subject to the review and approval of the Township Attorney.

5. A copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the New Jersey Division of Local Government Services.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING PLANNING BOARD TO UNDERTAKE A PRELIMINARY REDEVELOPMENT INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE DELINEATED AREA OF BLOCK 1131, LOTS 30-32 (331 NEWMAN SPRINGS ROAD) AND BLOCK 1086, LOTS 29-30, BLOCK 1089, LOTS 1 AND 2 (SCHULTZ DRIVE) SATISFIES THE CRITERIA FOR DESIGNATION AS AN AREA IN NEED OF REDEVELOPMENT FOR NON-CONDEMNATION PURPOSES

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq., the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law ("LRHL"), sets forth the criteria for a determination of whether a delineated area of a municipality may be designated as an area in need of redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6 authorizes the Township of Middletown (the "**Township**") to adopt a resolution directing its Planning Board to conduct a preliminary investigation to determine whether a delineated area is an area in need of redevelopment according to the criteria set forth under N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5 and N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-3; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to authorize its pre-qualified planning consultant, DMR Architects ("<u>DMR</u>"), to assist the Planning Board in its preliminary investigation of Block 1131, Lots 30-32 (331 Newman Springs Road), Block 1086, Lots 29-30, Block 1089, Lots 1 and 2 (Schultz Drive) to determine if the delineated area qualifies as an area in need of redevelopment for non-condemnation purposes pursuant to the criteria set forth under <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:12A-5 and <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:12A-3.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- The Planning Board is hereby authorized and requested to undertake a
 preliminary redevelopment investigation of Block 1131, Lots 30-32 (331
 Newman Springs Road), Block 1086, Lots 29-30, and Block 1089, Lots 1 and 2
 (Schultz Drive) to determine whether the delineated area of investigation
 warrants being designated as an "area in need of redevelopment" for noncondemnation purposes according to the criteria set forth under N.J.S.A.
 40A:12A-5 and N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-3.
- 2. DMR is hereby authorized to assist the Planning Board in its preliminary investigation of the delineated area of investigation, and to begin preparation of a Redevelopment Plan in the event the Planning Board

- recommends that all or some of the delineated area of investigation constitutes an "area in need of redevelopment."
- 3. The Township Administrator, DMR, Township Planner, and Township Attorney are each hereby authorized and directed to take any necessary and appropriate actions in connection with the investigation of the delineated area of investigation, and are hereby authorized and directed to take such actions, including but not limited to, the negotiation of any and all documents necessary to undertake the investigation.
- 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. 22-76

TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

RESOLUTION OPPOSING CONTINUED EXTENSION OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS BEYOND PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY AND SUPPORTING SENATE BILL NO. 1200 LIMITING THE GOVERNOR'S UNILATERAL EMERGENCY POWERS

WHEREAS, nearly two years ago, on March 9, 2020, Governor Murphy unilaterally declared a public health emergency by executive order; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's temporary emergency powers at the outset served the purpose of managing the COVID-19 pandemic at the time when the virus was spreading rapidly, vaccines and treatments were unavailable, and our healthcare system was being overwhelmed; and

WHEREAS, despite these conditions subsiding through the development of vaccines, therapies and a better understanding of the science behind the virus, the Governor has unilaterally renewed this public health emergency every 30 days thereafter until June 2021; and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2021, Governor Murphy signed legislation and an Executive Order ending the public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, at that time, the Legislature granted the Governor authority to continue certain emergency powers with respect to 14 Executive Orders only until January 11, 2022, thereafter, requiring that the Governor request an extension of these powers for up to 90 days; and

WHEREAS, the Governor made a request for a 90 day extension of these emergency powers and the Legislature refused to extend the Governor's emergency powers, but the Governor ignored the will of the Legislature and announced on January 12, 2022, that he was reinstating a statewide public health emergency, thereby allowing himself the ability to continue statewide mandates without the proper checks and balances required under State Constitution; and

WHEREAS, to date, Governor Murphy has unilaterally issued over 200 Executive Orders relating to the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2022, Senator Declan O'Scanlon introduced Senate Bill No. 1200, which limits the duration of states of emergency and public health emergencies declared by the Governor to 60 days unless an extension is authorized by the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, Senator Vin Gopal has joined Senator O'Scanlon as a prime sponsor of Senate Bill No. 1200, demonstrating bipartisan agreement that the Governor is abusing his emergency powers without legislative oversight; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown believes that it is well past time to return to the regular order of government in the State of New Jersey.

NOW, THERERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that it hereby opposes Governor Murphy's continuing unilateral declarations of a public health emergency and supports the enactment of Senate Bill No. 1200 to restore legislative oversight of the Governor's emergency powers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Clerk shall forward certified copies of this Resolution to the Office of the Governor, the members of Monmouth County's legislative delegation, the Monmouth County Board of Commissioners, and the New Jersey League of Municipalities.
