# TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

# ORDINANCE AMENDING § 240-15 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN GOVERNING RATES FOR ADDITIONAL SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING CARTS

WHEREAS, as part of the garbage and recycling program of the Township of Middletown (the "Township"), requests periodically are made for additional solid waste and recycling carts; and

**WHEREAS,** in order to provide additional carts and services beyond what is offered to all Township residents, fees must be set by ordinance; and

**WHEREAS,** the expiration of the prior contract term for solid waste and recycling collection requires certain amendments to the Township Code provisions governing the fees for additional carts and services during the current contract term.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that § 240-15 of the Code of the Township of Middletown be and is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

#### SECTION 1. Amendment to § 240-15(B) Solid waste carts.

 The cost for service and rental of an additional solid waste cart of any size shall be pursuant to the following schedule for the five three-year term of the solid waste collection contract:

- 2. The cost is fixed for the applicable calendar year; there shall be no proration between calendar years.
- At the conclusion of the <u>five</u> <u>three</u>-year term of the contract period, a new fee schedule will be established based on collection costs at that time.

### SECTION 2. Amendment to § 240-15(C) Recycling carts.

- 1. The cost for service and rental of an additional recycling cart of any size shall be \$100 regardless of the year in which the additional cart is secured.
- At the conclusion of the <u>five</u> <u>three</u>-year term of the contract period, a
  new fee schedule will be established based on collection costs at that
  time.

#### **SECTION 3.** Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed. All portions of the ordinance not modified herein remain in full force and effect.

#### **SECTION 4. Severability.**

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

#### **SECTION 5. Effective Date.**

This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, adoption and publication in the manner prescribed by law.

# TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

Ordinance Adopting The 100 Schultz Drive Redevelopment Plan Within The Exit 109 Redevelopment Plan Area Consisting Of Block 1086, Lot 30

WHEREAS, on February 7, 2002, the governing body of the Township of Middletown (the "Township"), acting as the Township's Redevelopment Entity, adopted Resolution No. 22-75, authorizing its professional redeveloper planner, DMR Architects ("DMR"), to commence a redevelopment investigation within the delineated area of Block 1131, Lots 30-32, Block 1086, Lots 29-30, Block 1089, Lots 1-2 (the "Area of Investigation") to determine if the area qualifies as an area in need of redevelopment for non-condemnation purposes pursuant to the criteria set forth under N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5 and N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-3; and

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2022, the Planning Board conducted a properly noticed public hearing at which DMR presented an April 2022 report entitled "Report of Preliminary Investigation for Determination of an Area in Need of Redevelopment" for the Area of Investigation (the "Investigation Study"), determining that Block 1086, Lots 29-30, and Block 1131, Lots 30-32 within the Area of Investigation meet the statutory criteria to be designated as an Area in Need of Redevelopment for non-condemnation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board concurred with the findings of the Investigation Study, recommending that Block 1086, Lots 29-30, and Block 1131, Lots 30-32 be designated in need of redevelopment for non-condemnation purposes; and

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2022, the governing body of the Township adopted Resolution No. 22-153 accepting the Planning Board's recommendation adopting the findings of the Investigation Study and declaring that Block 1086, Lots 29-30, and Block 1131, Lots 30-32 (the "Exit 109 Redevelopment Plan Area") be designated in need of redevelopment for non-condemnation purposes based on the criteria set forth under N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5 and N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-3; and

**WHEREAS,** redevelopment plans must be undertaken by ordinance pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-7, and said plans must include an outline for the planning, development, redevelopment or rehabilitation of the identified project area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township's professional redevelopment planner, DMR, has prepared a Redevelopment Plan entitled the "100 Schultz Drive Redevelopment Plan" dated January 2023 including Block 1086, Lot 30 within the Exit 109 Redevelopment Plan Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township's governing body wishes to adopt the 100 Schultz Drive Redevelopment Plan consisting of Block 1086, Lot 30 within the Exit 109 Redevelopment Plan Area.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1. 100 Schultz Drive Redevelopment Plan.** The 100 Schultz Drive Redevelopment Plan dated January 2023 prepared by DMR, attached hereto and made part hereof as **Exhibit A** is hereby approved and adopted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq., shall supersede the current zoning applied to Block 1086, Lot 30, and be enacted as an amendment to the Township's Zoning Map.

**SECTION 2. Severability.** If any section, subsection or paragraph of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional, invalid or inoperative, in whole or in part, by a court of competent jurisdiction, such chapter, section subchapter or paragraph shall to the extent that is not held unconstitutional, invalid or inoperative remain in full force and effect and shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance.

**SECTION 3. Repealer.** All ordinances and resolutions, and parts of ordinances and resolutions which are inconsistent with provisions of this ordinance shall be, and are hereby, repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption and approval pursuant to law.

# TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

Ordinance Amending § 7-32 Of The Code Of The Township Of Middletown Governing The Township Attorney's Position

WHEREAS, the Township of Middletown (the "<u>Township</u>") is removing the Township Attorney from a salaried position to a contractual arrangement, therefore, requiring certain amendments that had previously structured the position of Township Attorney as a salaried employee addressing generally only routine legal matters under said salary; and

**WHEREAS,** these amendments are called for to properly reflect the current role of the Township Attorney and contemporary structure of the position.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that § 7-32 of the Code of the Township of Middletown is hereby amended and supplemented, as follows:

#### **SECTION 1.** Amendments to § 7-32.

#### § 7-32. Township Attorney.

- **A. Appointment.** The Township Attorney shall be an individual appointed annually to serve as the Township's Municipal Attorney and designated legal officer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:9-139.
- B. Compensation. The Township Attorney shall be compensated <u>pursuant to an</u> annually negotiated contract entered between the Township Attorney and/or <u>their law firm and the Township</u>. by a flat fee retainer, within the available <u>limits of appropriations, in an amount specified within the Township's applicable salary ordinances</u>.
- C. Duties. The scope of the Township Attorney's services shall include, but not necessarily be limited to: provided pursuant to the retainer relating to routine and reoccurring legal matters, shall be as follows:
  - Provide general counsel to the Township Committee, Administrator and departments, except where alternate counsel is required by law or court rules.

- 2. Approve all resolutions, ordinances and instruments as to form and defensibility before introduction and approval.
- 3. Draft resolutions, ordinances and instruments. not requiring extraordinary legal research and analysis.
- 4. Attend regular, workshop and special meetings of the Township Committee and give opinions on general questions of law that may arise at such meetings.
- 5. Provide management, recommendations and support in relation to litigation, trials, appeals and administrative proceedings to which the Township, its officers or employees may be a party to that are assigned to special counsel pursuant to resolution for the provision of professional legal services above and beyond the duties of the appointed Township Attorney as prescribed herein.

#### D. Additional duties. The Township Attorney shall also:

- 6. Maintain records of all actions, suits, proceedings and matters which relate to the Township's interest and report thereon from time to time as the Township Administrator or Township Committee may require.
- 7. Have power to enter into any agreement, compromise or settlement of any litigation in which the Township is involved, subject to the approval of the Township Committee.
- 8. Upon termination of service with the Township, forthwith surrender to the designated successor or Township Administrator all Township property, papers and records, together with a written consent to substitute the Township Attorney or special counsel, as applicable, in any pending actions or proceedings.
- 9. Special counsel. Whenever deemed to be in the interests of the Township, the Township Attorney, with the approval of the Township Committee, may appoint special counsel to assist in the preparation, trial or argument of any issue or proceeding, or in such other capacity as may be needed. If the Township Attorney should be disqualified with respect to any matter, the Township Committee may appoint special counsel to represent the Township for and with respect to such matter.
- F. Repealer. All ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistency. Ordinance No. 2008-2940<sup>[1]</sup> is repealed in its entirety.

[1] Editor's Note: Ordinance No. 2008-2940 provided for compensation of the Township Attorney.

G. Effective date. Upon final passage and publication as provided by law, this section shall take effect nunc pro tunc to January 1, 2009, and is intended to effectuate and ratify the appointment of the Township Attorney and the professional services agreement authorized pursuant to Resolution No. 09 001.

#### SECTION 2. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed. All portions of the ordinance not modified herein remain in full force and effect.

#### **SECTION 3.** Severability.

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

#### **SECTION 4.** Effective Date.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that:

- 1. It hereby authorizes and directs the Mayor and Township Administrator to make an application to the DCA for a grant not to exceed \$100,000 to carry out a project to complete Phase 2 of improvements to the Tonya Keller Community Center.
- 2. It hereby recognizes and accepts that the DCA may offer a lesser or greater amount; and therefore, upon receipt of the grant agreement from the DCA, does further authorize the execution of any such grant agreement; and also, upon receipt of the fully executed agreement from the DCA, does further authorize the expenditure of funds pursuant to the terms of the agreement between the Township and the DCA.
- 3. It hereby designates the persons whose names, titles, and signatures appear below are authorized to sign the application, and that they or their successors in said titles are authorized to sign the agreement, and any other documents necessary in connection therewith:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN, THROUGH THE MIDDLETOWN TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DEFENSE LOGISTICS AGENCY LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPORT OFFICE 1033 PROGRAM TO ENABLE THE MIDDLETOWN TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT TO REQUEST AND ACQUIRE EXCESS DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS the United State Congress authorized the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) 1033 Program the Program to make use of excess Department of Defense personal property by making that personal property available to municipal, county and State law enforcement agencies: and

WHEREAS DLA rules mandate that all equipment acquired through the 1033 Program remain under the control of the requesting law enforcement agency: and

**WHEREAS**, participation in the 1033 Program allows municipal and county law enforcement agencies to obtain property they might not otherwise be able to afford in order to enhance community preparedness, response, and resiliency; and

**WHEREAS**, although property is provided through the 1033 Program at no cost to municipal and county law enforcement agencies, these entities are responsible for the costs associated with delivery, maintenance, fueling, and upkeep of the property, and for specialized training on the operation of any acquired property: and

WHEREAS <u>N.J.S.A. 40A:5-30.2</u> requires that the governing body of the municipality or county approve, by a majority of the full membership, both enrollment in, and the acquisition of any property through, the 1033 Program; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by** the TOWNSHIP **COMMITTEE** of the **TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN** that the **MIDDLETOWN TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT** is hereby authorized to enroll in the 1033 Program for a one-year period from January 1st, 2023, to December 31, 2023.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the **MIDDLETOWN TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT** is hereby authorized to acquire items of non-controlled property designated "DEMIL A", which may include office supplies, office furniture, computers, electronic equipment, generators, field packs, non-military vehicles, clothing, traffic and transit signal systems, exercise equipment, farming and moving equipment, storage devices

and containers, tools, medical and first aid equipment and supplies, personal protection equipment and supplies, construction materials, lighting supplies, beds and sleeping mats, wet and cold weather equipment and supplies, respirators, binoculars, and any other supplies or equipment of a non-military nature identified by the LEA, if it shall become available in the next twelve months, based on the needs of the MIDDLETOWN TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT, without restriction; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that **MIDDLETOWN TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT** is authorized to acquire "DEMIL B through Q" property, if it shall become available in the next six months, upon passage of a separate resolution specifying the type of controlled property sought; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief of Police or his designee shall develop and implement a full training plan and policy for the maintenance and use of the acquired property; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the **MIDDLETOWN TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT** shall provide a quarterly accounting of all property obtained through the 1033 Program which shall be available to the public upon request: and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall take effect immediately shall be valid to authorize requests to acquire "DEMIL A" property that may be made available through the 1033 Program until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023 and requests to acquire "DEMIL B through Q" property that may be made available through the 1033 Program until June 30, 2023.

### Resolution Authorizing Renewal of Agreement with the Monmouth County SPCA for Housing of Stray Animals

WHEREAS, the Monmouth County SPCA, a nonprofit organization, provides housing, adoption and related services for stray animals for the Township of Middletown ("Township"); and

**WHEREAS,** there are limited facilities for the housing of stray animals in the County of Monmouth at this time; and

WHEREAS, since the enactment of the bail reform law in January 2017, motor vehicle thefts and associated crimes in Monmouth County have increased by 40% with more than one-third of those being arrested and released committing the same crime again; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Middletown (the "<u>Township</u>") has been forced to increase police patrols and significantly increase expenditures to combat the surge in auto thefts and associated crimes that statistically correlates with the enactment of the bail reform law; and

**WHEREAS**, since the bail reform was enacted, the Township's taxpayers have been forced to cover hundreds of thousands of dollars of unfunded costs associated with combating and investigating auto thefts and associated crimes on an annually reoccurring basis; and

**WHEREAS,** the bail reform law, therefore, violates  $\underline{\text{N.J.S.A.}}$  52:13H-2 because the State has "not authorize[d] resources to offset the additional direct expenditures required for the implementation of the law . . ."; and

**WHEREAS,** under the State Constitution, the Council is empowered to act to eliminate such unfunded mandates imposed upon municipal governments by the State.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that it hereby authorizes and directs the Township Attorney to file a Complaint with the Council to address the above-recited unfunded mandate that the bail reform law has imposed upon municipal governments.

WHEREAS, the Township and Jeffrey Paris and Linda Paris (the "Owners") entered into an Affordable Housing Agreement, Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions of Accessory Apartments (the "Agreement") dated May 11, 2012, effective November 1, 2012 (the "Effective Date"), relating to certain real property located at Block 178, Lot 2 on the official tax map of the Township of Middletown, County of Monmouth, and more commonly known as 25 Nevada Avenue (the "Property") owned by the Owners; and

**WHEREAS,** the Agreement was recorded in the Office of the Monmouth County Clerk on October 25, 2012 in Deed Book: OR-8978 at Page 2087&c against the Property; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Agreement, the Owners were restricted to rent the accessory apartment (the "<u>Accessory Apartment</u>") situated on the Property to certified modified income households only in order to maintain the affordability controls for a period of no less than ten (10) years from the Effective Date; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Agreement, the affordability controls, covenants and restrictions set forth in the Agreement (the "<u>Restrictions</u>") expired on November 1, 2022 (the "<u>Expiration Date</u>"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Expiration Date has passed, and the Owners have requested that the Restrictions be discharged and released from the Property's title; and

**WHEREAS,** it is the recommendation of the Township's Director of Planning and Township Administrator to release the Restrictions on the Property by executing a Quit Claim Deed Releasing Ownership Unit from Affordability Controls attached hereto as <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a> as the Owner is not required to and/or was not willing to renew the Property's affordability controls.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that the

Township's Administrative Agent is hereby authorized in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:80-26.5(i) to take all necessary actions required to release the affordable housing restrictions on the Property.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor, Township Clerk and Township Attorney are authorized to execute the appropriate release and all documents necessary to effectuate the release the affordable housing restrictions on the Property as set forth herein.
