City Attorney:

The City Attorney talked about the difference between the Resolution and the Ordinance for the bar staying open longer on Sundays. Once the ordinance passes then we can will change the time for good. Next, the City Attorney stated that we can lease our books art work. He will make a resolution for that and an agreement. The business has to register their fire alarm system through a third party and we go off that. His question was does have Crimson Fire need a business license. The Fire Chief thought he should and be treated like a contractor. He does not have to have a license though. Mayor stated we will look into it. The Mayor also stated that the parade was good.
