1. Mayor ask the Council if they had any questions on the budget for FY 22? Councilman Hollander wanted to know about property tax and how much goes where. The Mayor stated that the City gets 8 mills, and the school district gets a big portion of it. Mayor stated that the county as a whole has not changed that much so we should start to see some more revenue from all the building that has been happening.

Mayor also stated with the increase in cost we will have to raise water, sewer and sanitation rates. He suggested that instead of raising the base rate we should raise the per 1000 after. Sewer he would like to see a 5% increase as well as sanitation. Mayor suggested to the City Clerk that we need to get a hold of the commercial companies and see who there are with and show them how we can save them money.

Mayor stated that the police will need three more vehicles and we will still keep it in a rotation of sanitation trucks.

The Mayor also stated that he would like to unfreeze wages.

There were no more questions. Council is to review the budget for next meeting.


